How To Pray On The Armor

The following scriptures can be used as examples of how to "pray on" the Armor Of God:

Heavenly Father I recognize through your Word that Satan's desire is to **Divide** & **Draw** me away from You, my Family and my Assembly. He seeks to **Divert** me from your purpose in my life. His wiles are geared towards **Denying** You of Your rightful glory and honor as a result of me living a life of obedience. He seeks to **Deceive** and **Destroy** me.

My Father I pray for heavenly wisdom and discernment in my daily battles.

In obedience to Your Words I take up and put on the glorious armor You have given me. I ask for victory in each of my spiritual battles this day Father, for Thy glory I pray.

The Belt Of Truth

Around my mind I put the belt of truth. Father I pray that my thoughts and life are firmly fastened upon the Truths of your Words. I pray for Thy strength to energize me through Your Words. I pray I will be able to resist all temptations through the foundation of the Scriptures. Allow me to be spiritually quick and agile as I wrap the truth of Thy Word around my mind. Protect me on every side so I may live a God honoring life of sincerity guided by a heart which *loves* and *lives* Thy Truth. (1 Peter 1:13-16; 2 Corinthians 6:7)

The Breastplate Of Righteousness

On my heart I put the breastplate of righteousness. Father I am so thankful for Christ's righteousness bestowed upon me. I recognize the work that was done **in** me in Salvation. Being made a new creature **in** Christ I pray that today I am lead by the Spirit of God in my spiritual battles. I pray my heart is kept from sin and that my inner faith is seen in my outward acts of love. My Lord Jesus I declare that your righteousness will defend my heart from all wounds and harms from sin. Through your victory of the cross I can stand victorious against temptation, sin and the attacks of our enemy. Surround my heart in this truth and embolden me to continue to stand victorious for Thy glory.(Isaiah 59:17-18; 1 Thessalonians 5:8)

The Shoes Of Preparation and Peace

On my feet, I put the shoes of the gospel. Father, I pledge to follow your marching orders in declaring the Gospel today as you provide opportunity. I know that whatever the Devil may say you and I are at peace one with another. We are reconciled through my Saviors sacrifice for me. I know that You will fight for me and I stand secure in Your power to defeat the enemy. I praise you for the ability to have a good conscience with myself and others. I pray you keep my feet firmly planted in this truth so that I am prepared for those darts which are aimed at preventing me from your Commission. I ask that the assurance of the Gospel of peace readies me to step out in faith to bring that same Gospel to others. Allow me to make right decisions and follow the direction you have for my life this day, for today is the day of salvation. (Romans 10:15; 2 Cor 5:18 – 2 Cor 6:2)

The Shield Of Faith

In my hand I take up the shield of faith. Father I pray that I rely fully upon Thee this day. I understand that knowing the promises of Your Words is not enough. I must believe them with all my heart. I pray that I do not rely on my own understanding but whole heartedly surrender myself to Thy control. Fill me with inherent power so I am able to be victorious. Protect me from the darts of the enemy today as I rely solely upon Your power. Oh Lord increase my faith so I may go forward this day doing Thy will. (Hebrews 11:33–34; 1 John 5:4-5)

The Helmet Of Salvation

On my head, I receive the helmet of salvation with eagerness and anticipation. The helmet is my Hope which is my Salvation. Father, unlike the world I have a great hope. Jesus is my salvation and my deliverance. I wrap this knowledge firmly about my mind as a helmet. I pray this day that I live for Thee with full knowledge of my salvation and all the many blessings You have afforded me. I pray victory over Satan that He is not able to take these truths from me and discourage me. Deliver me from all sins and weaknesses. Cover me with strength, peace and anointing and bring me to complete wholeness in you. (Isaiah 59:17; 1 Thessalonians 5:8–11)

The Sword Of The Spirit

In my hand I take up the sword of the Spirit, the powerful Words of God. Father I pray that the Holy Spirit bring back to remembrance the specific, spiritually empowered Words of Scripture I need for each specific battle this day. Quicken Your Words and bring them alive in my mind so that I may wield them effectively and powerfully. (Psalm 119:92-94; Matthew 4:1-11; Hebrews 4:12)

Prayer and Supplication

From my heart and lips I offer prayer and supplications. Father you are the commander of all Spiritual engagements. Keep me mindful that each and every action and consideration of this day should come from our prayerful communion. Remind me I need to not only listen but obey. Help me to make my prayer a constant exercise so that I may draw nigh unto Thee. Strengthen my spirit thought our time of prayer. I ask for diligence, attentiveness and the ability to steadfastly continue in my supplications. (Romans 8:26-28; Philippians 4:6; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)
