- KJV **Rom 7:14** For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.
- ¹⁵ For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I.
- ¹⁶ If then **I** do that which **I** would not, **I** consent unto the law that *it is* good.
- ¹⁷ Now then it is no more I **that do it**, but sin that dwelleth in me.
- ¹⁸ For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but *how* to perform that which is good I find not.
- ¹⁹ For the good that I **would** I **do not**: but the evil which I would not, **that** I **do**.
- ²⁰ Now if **I** do that **I** would not, it is no more **I** that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.
- ²¹ I find then a law, that, when I **would do** good, evil is present with me.
- ²² For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:
- ²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.
- ²⁴ O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?
- ²⁵ I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.
