

^{KJV} **Rom 7:14** For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

¹⁵ For **that which I do** I allow not: for what I **would**, **that do I not**; but what I hate, **that do I**.

¹⁶ If then **I do** that which I **would** not, I consent unto the law that *it is* good.

¹⁷ Now then it is no more I **that do it**, but sin that dwelleth in me.

¹⁸ For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to **will** is present with me; but *how* **to perform** that which is good I find not.

¹⁹ For the good that I **would** I **do not**: but the evil which I would not, **that I do**.

²⁰ Now if **I do** that I **would** not, it is no more I **that do it**, but sin that dwelleth in me.

²¹ I find then a law, that, when I **would do** good, evil is present with me.

²² For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

²⁴ O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

²⁵ I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.
