

Ignorance of the History of Baptists

Every generation needs to be taught the truth. This fact is true relative to the family, society, or religion. Certainly this is the case for Baptists; every new generation of Baptists needs to be inculcated in the doctrine and history of Baptists. Unfortunately for Baptists, however, some generations have missed Baptist teaching and consequently many years pass without a continuous indoctrination in Baptist truth. "Baptist" is a biblical term, and the first Christians and the Lord Jesus Christ were Baptists (Mt. 3:1-17).

Several reasons may be put forth for the ignorance of Baptist history among Baptist churches. 1. The Modernist / Fundamentalist controversy beginning in the early 20th century labeled believers' immersion as a non-essential and consequently promoted non-denominationalism. 2. The extreme view of Landmarkism, or a visible lineage of Baptist churches back to the first century, caused many Baptists to accept the faulty view that Baptists came out of the Protestant reformation. 3. The universal church /

mystical body of Christ heresy has caused many Baptists to misunderstand the New Testament teaching on Christ's church (*ekklesia* [$\epsilon \kappa \lambda \eta \sigma i \alpha$]), and identify "church" history as Roman Catholic and Protestant.

The seminary course on Baptist History is an effort to teach Baptists about their rich biblical and theological history, based on the biblical teaching of the immersionist church movement through the first century (e.g., the Book of Acts) down to the present time (Mt. 28:19-20; I Tim. 3:15).

Swimming Iron: Text: 2 Kings 6:1-7



The Situation – the dwelling place of the sons of prophets was to small

1. And the sons of the prophets said unto Elisha, Behold now, the place where we dwell with thee is too strait for us.

The Request and the Answer

2. Let us go, we pray thee, unto Jordan, and take thence every man a beam, and let us make us a place there, where we may dwell. And he answered, Go ye.

Elisha goes with the servants

3. And one said, Be content, I pray thee, and go with thy servants. And he answered, I will go.

Elisha and the servants came to Jordan and there cut down trees

4. So he went with them. And when they came to Jordan, they cut down wood.

One servant's axe head fell into the water as he was felling wood for the house

He cried to the master The axe head was borrowed

5. But as one was felling a beam, the axe head fell into the water: and he cried, and said, Alas, master! for it was borrowed.

Elisha miraculously recovered the axe head

6. And the man of God said, Where fell it? And he shewed him the place. And he cut down a stick, and cast it in thither; and the iron did swim.

The servant received again the axe head


7. Therefore said he, Take it up to thee. And he put out his hand, and took it.

LESSONS LEARNED:

- 1. There are always situations that arise in life that need our attention (1). In this case, the dwelling was too small for the number of the sons of the prophets.
- 2. When change is necessary, it is good to seek the advice of the man of God (1-2).

- When change is happening, one needs to be considerate (3) In this case, they invited the man of God to go with them and he accepted. Lesson: "Consideration begets consideration" T h e sons of the prophets were considerate to ask, Elisha was considerate to answer and accept.
- 4. Take care of the business at hand without delay (4). No procrastination!
- 5. Sometimes problems arise (5) In this case the axe head fell into the water.
 - Immediately report the problem to the one in charge.
 - Give him all the facts of the problem. In this case: The axe head fell somewhere into the water. The axe head was borrowed.
- 6. As the man of God, always be ready to help in all situations (6)
 - Whether mundane or spiritual
 - Take immediate action
 - Rely upon God's help, and not your own understanding
- 7. Remember the man of God can help, but personal responsibility is expected (7). -CAR


