#### **Biblical Proofs for Assurance of Salvation**

1. Do you desire to fellowship with God? "That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ" (I Jn. 1:3).

- 2. Are you sensitive to sin? "If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:6-9).
- 3. Do you obey the Bible? "And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments" (I Jn. 2:3).
- 4. Do you love other Christians? "He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes" (1 John 2:9-11).
- 5. Do you have distaste for the world? "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (I Jn. 2:15).
- 6. Do you sense the Spirit of God working in your life? "But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him" (I Jn. 2:27).
- **7.** Do you anticipate the coming of Christ? "Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth

- not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure" (1 John 3:2-3).
- **8. Do you experience answered prayers?** "And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight" (I Jn. 3:22).
- 9. Can you discern between spiritual truth and error? "Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world" (1 John 4:1-3).

#### **Biblical Scolarship**

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:

1 Timothy 6:20

Men seem to be enamored with scholarship. For many who seek the accolade of scholarship, for them, it is a means to an end, in their quest for the approval of men. Some men who pursue scholarship, it is a way to fortune, while for

others it is a way to fame and for others it is a way for reaching a place or position above their peers.

Many men have equated scholarship solely with human effort in their quest for truth, yet real truth cannot be found apart from the Bible. Jesus said, "Thy word is truth" (John 17:17). The Psalmist said, "...all thy commandments are truth" (Psalm 119:151). Nor can real truth be acquired without the LORD. The biblical scholar Daniel understood that it was God who gave wisdom. He acknowledged it when he said, "Blessed be

the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: ...he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding" (Daniel 2:21). Therefore, true scholarship is Biblical scholarship, which is to possess the knowledge of what God has declared right or wrong, and what is true or false. For instance, consider the guestion: was the earth created as God declares or did it evolve as some men declare? Honest scholarship will consider both thoughts, but must choose what an infallible God declares (Genesis 1:1) over what some fallible men think may have happened. Either way both positions are faith based. Some will believe the facts as God puts them forth and some will believe the facts as men put them forth. Whose facts do you want to believe: God's facts based upon His infallible word or man's facts based upon his fallible rationale.


For the Christian, true scholarship is not an ignorance of truth, but it is rather the acknowledgement of God's Truth. It holds all disciplines of study and their conclusions to be in subjection to His truth, which is revealed in the whole context of the Holy Scripture. -CAR

"God alone is Lord of the conscience, and hath



as he gives the biblical defense for the KJV and underlying texts, representing forty-five years of seasoned argumentation through theological essays and public debates for the word of God.


