

DEVOTIONAL CORNER

Mandates in Practical Living

Text: 2 Timothy 2:14-26



Practical godly living does not save anyone. However it does demonstrate the salvation that God has given us through His Son, Jesus Christ. Because we have been saved and declared righteous, God has set us apart, sanctifying us for His purposes. It

is this position before God that calls us to a practical life of sanctification as we live our Christian life.


When the Apostle Paul wrote to Timothy, he revealed both positive and negative mandates to live a sanctified godly life. First, the positive mandates: 1) Remember the injunctions of the word of God (2 Timothy 2:14); 2) Study the Scriptures, rightly dividing them (2 Timothy 2:15): And 3) follow after righteousness, faith, charity, peace (2 Timothy 2:22). These are the positive mandates for practical living that Paul shared with Timothy.

Like a battery that energizes things to run properly, and which has both a positive and negative aspect, so is the energizing aspect of godly living. Regarding the negative mandates revealed, they are: 1) Shun words and conversations that cause a promotion ungodliness (2 Timothy 2:16); 2) Depart from iniquity, which is the flagrant disobedience to what God has revealed that we should do (2 Timothy 2:19); Flee youthful lusts or desires (2 Tim.2:22). At this point, I would call to the reader's attention the progressive nature of these negative mandates. We are to shun (to turn from), depart (to leave) and flee (to run from, escape by flight). Finally, Paul reveals that we are to avoid (to refuse, decline) language that genders strife and guestions, language that is unhelpful in building character and strength in godly practical living that projects our salvation and sanctification, which we have in the Lord Jesus Christ (2 Timothy 2:23-26). -CAR



for the KJV and underlying texts, representing forty-five years of seasoned argumentation through theological essays and public debates for the word of God.


