

1. Trust the Lord, asking for deliverance (1) (14)

"In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in thy righteousness."

"But I trusted in thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my God.

2. Ask the Lord for His safety (2)

"Bow down thine ear to me; deliver me speedily: be thou my strong rock, for an house of defence to save me."

3. Ask for the Lord for His leading and guiding (3)

"For thou art my rock and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me."

4. Commit your spirit (life) to the Lord (5)

"Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth."

5. Hate those that regard lying vanities (6) (separate from the temporal lusts of life)

"I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD."

6. Rejoice in the mercy (goodness) of the Lord (7) (21)

"I will be glad and rejoice in thy mercy: for thou hast

considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities;"

"Blessed be the LORD: for he hath shewed me his marvellous kindness in a strong city."

7. Witness openly before men of the goodness of the Lord (19)

"Oh how great is thy goodness, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men!"

8. Love the Lord (23)

"O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer."

9. Be of good courage (strong) in the Lord (24a)

"Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD."


10. Hope in the Lord (24b)

DEVOTIONAL FOR WOMEN

Devotion to Parenting God's Way?

2 Timothy 3:1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

2 Timothy 3:2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

2 Timothy 3:3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers,

incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

2 Timothy 3:4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

Reflection: We are in the last days and have been since the Lord Jesus Christ resurrected. As the days progress we can see evil and the horrors of wickedness intensify.

Speak with your young children, explaining what some of the words in these verses mean and let them know that these behaviours are sinful when exhibited. Help them to understand that it is your responsibility, because you love them, to lead them in the way they should go. Parents today are fighting an uphill battle since the ways of the world are in complete contradiction to God's way of raising children, but God has given His Word to equip a parent. A Christian's parenting and their children's behaviour should look differently than the parenting of non-Christians and their children's behaviours, should they not?

Currently, as a preschool teacher of (22) three year olds, I see a plethora of children yelling at parents, hitting them, talking back, ignoring them when instructed, and the parents are often times at a loss which then

exasperates the disrespect. Can you see that these behaviours are the behaviours spoken of in these verses?

Titus 1:6 If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or unruly.

The Lord's Word says that there are conditions a Pastor and his family must meet to be ordained by the Lord. His children should not be riotous or unruly but in subjection, do you think this should apply to all children in Christian homes? Are not Christians to be representatives and ambassadors for Christ with a good testimony? Do your children know this, that they are held to this standard? Communicate it at a level they can begin to understand.

Titus 2:4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children.

Titus 2:5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Challenge: What area of parenting do you feel weakest in? How do your children look differently than the world? And the same? When you look at your life, what percentage of your time and energy is focused on training your children? Are you fulfilling Titus 2:4? This can be especially difficult for working mom's who come home tired. What are some Biblical examples of how to love your children?


