Real Believing is Whole Hearted



for salvation (Rm.10:13).

As Christians: we learn that a sinner (whosoever) can call upon the Lord and be saved. But it must be done properly. It must be a real, whole hearted, and a genuine call of faith on the part of the sinner (Rm.10:9-10).

There is a difference in intellectual

Pastor Cas Reeves accent to Christ and heart acceptance of Christ, of an insincere belief and a genuine belief. Salvation is not obtained: 1) without God's Word (Rm.10:13; Heb.11:6; Acts 8:35), 2) without conviction by the Holy Spirit which brings repentance (Acts 2:37; Jn.16:8-9) and 3) without heart (genuine) acceptance of Christ by the individual (Rm.10:9-10). Note the phrase in vs.10, "...with the heart man believeth unto righteousness..." Salvation happens when God declares one righteous. An individual is saved not by his effort (Eph.2:8-9), but through the righteousness of Christ (2 Cor.5:21). God declares one righteous, when one receives or confesses Jesus Christ (Rm.10:9). That receiving

must be whole hearted (Rm.10:9-10) and by a genuine

belief in God's justifying ability (Rm.4:5-6), a true faith, a real faith, a sincere faith that is willing to call on Jesus Christ

Understanding that the heart is the seat of the human spirit, the residence of the man's will, the control room of one's life: It is with the heart one makes the basic decisions of his life. Prov:23:7, "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he:" The heart implies the person's total sincerity. For example: To one's wife a man may say, "I love you with all my heart." It speaks of his total sincerity, his genuineness, that he really means it. It is with that realness or genuineness that one must call upon Christ to save them. Only time and biblical evidences (Mt.7:20) of salvation reveals to men the true sincerity of a man's profession of faith in Christ. However, the Lord knows immediately (Jn.2:23-25). And if it is not real and genuine faith that calls, they don't get saved. Which is usually evidenced in time by their works.

Sometimes in the quest for numbers or perhaps the zealousness for winning souls it has lead us to an "easy believeism" or a "quick profession of faith." But in the end, we watch the poor souls wither because there is no life in them. That life -- must come from Christ (1Jn.5:12) and if he does not commit himself unto them -- they do not have life. Some, may even follow in baptism and church membership, but eventually, if they don't really get saved, they fade back into the darkness, which they love rather than the light (Jn.3:19). They leave us because they are not of us (1Jn.2:19) or they mix with us as tares amongst the wheat, but God knows! (Mt.13:29-30). - CAR
