educate and enforce the truth, "Children, obey your parents" (Eph. 6:1):

I. Husband and Wife = both need to be saved

a. One saved and other is unsaved -> I Corinthians 7:12-14

b. Faithful church members (baptized, using spiritual gift, tithing...)

c. To be Spirit Filled – Ephesians 5:18

d. Humility – Ephesians 4:2

II. The Role of the Husband before God = **Ephesians 5**

a. Head of the Wife = Eph.5: 23

b. Love your wife – Eph. 5:25

i. As Christ loved the church – Eph. 5: 25

ii. As your own body - Eph.5: 28

c. Be not bitter against your wife - Colossians 3:19

d. Be joined unto his wife - Eph.5: 31 Devoted, emotionally attached

e. Provide food and shelter for his family – I Timothy 5:8

f. I Peter 3:7 - "Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered."

III. The Role of the Wife before God

a. Be subject to their own Husbands – Eph.

- c. To be holy Titus 2:3-5
- d. To be virtuous Proverbs 31:10-31

IV. The Role of Parents

a. Demand obedience and respect from Children – Eph. 6:1-3

b. Provoke not your children to wrath – Eph. 6:4, Col. 3:21

c. Bring them up or rear them – Eph. 6:4

i. Nurture – training in wisdom -> See Book of Proverbs!

ii. Admonition – warning, cautionary advice -> see Book of Proverbs!

d. Teach them the Book of Proverbs

i. To know Wisdom and Instruction -Proverbs 1:2

ii. To perceive the words of understanding -Proverbs 1:2

iii. "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge" – Prov. 1:7

e. Use the Rod of Correction

i. Proverbs 13:24 – "He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes."

ii. Proverbs 29:15 – "The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame"

iii. Proverbs 23:13-14 – "Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die"

iv. Proverbs 22:15 – "Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him"

v. **Proverbs 22:6** – *"Train up a child in the way* he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it"

vi. Proverbs 29:17 "Correct thy son, and he

shall give thee rest; yea, he shall give delight unto thy soul"

V. The Role of Children

a. To obey their parents - Eph. 6:1

b. To honor their parents – Eph. 6:2-3

c. To obey their parents – Colossians 3:20

VI. Accountability to the Lord for our Biblical Roles

a. God is going to judge every believer as an *individual*, not as a *couple!*

i. Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 – "Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. 14 For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil"

ii. I Corinthians 3: 13 – "Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is"

b. Every Man and Woman will be judged for the roles the Lord gave them

i. Husband, Wife, Father, Mother, and Child.

c. My Spouse is not saved -> I Corinthians 7:12-14

d. My Spouse is not Spirit-filled today/ often...what do I do?

i. "Be ye filled with the Spirit" – Eph. 5:18

ii. Your spouse's sin is not an excuse for you to sin and/or perpetuate sin.

e. Example of a Saved Couple:

i. "The Vicious Cycle" {{A wife refuses to respect her husband because he has not been loving and gentle to her recently; he has been gruff, short, and mean to her. }}

ii. This most common cycle is difficult to break because one party has to "Give in" and be the "Bigger Person".

iii. As a believer, once you realize that YOU are not Spirit-filled, YOU need to get right with the Lord immediately and be obedient to whatever role the Lord has given you.

iv. This requires believers to frequently "Check-in" on their own heart and spirit to ensure they are right with the Lord.

1. **Psalm 19:14** *"Let the words of my mouth, And the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer"*

2. **Psalm 51:3-4** – *"For I acknowledge my transgressions: And my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, And done this evil in thy sight"*

v. Why? Because the Lord is going to judge you according to your role. Did you behave like a biblical husband, wife, or child??

vi. Do not worry...the Lord will judge your spouse that is in sin too!

THE SAVED SERVANT



Titus 1:1: "Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;"

As the Apostle Paul opens the epistle to Titus he describes himself by first calling himself a servant of God. He uses the Greek word ($\delta o \upsilon \lambda \alpha \sigma$), which is translated servant. The idea behind this word is a slave of God. Paul was saved and realized he no longer belonged to himself, but to God; his life was no longer his own to govern himself, but to be governed by God.

Paul continues by describing himself as an apostle of Jesus Christ. The word apostle not only describes a position, but a purpose. The word apostle is the Greek word ($\alpha\pi\sigma\sigma\tau\sigma\lambda\sigma\zeta$), which means a messenger or one who is sent. Paul in his description is basically giving his credentials or authority for what he is going to ask of Titus.

Paul also reveals the basis of what he is saying. He uses the Greek preposition ($\kappa \alpha \tau \alpha$) translated accordingly meaning in accord with, and he names two things. The first reason he gives is on the basis or in accordance with the faith of

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

II Timothy 2:15



God's elect. This is the faith of God's saved. The faith that comes through God's word (Romans 10:17) and the faith that is in Jesus Christ's merits (John 11:25). The second reason Paul gives is on the basis of truth. This truth is God's truth or His word (John17:17). It is truth, which is clearly recognized as being after godliness.

Thus, Paul describes himself in this opening verse, and although this is a particular description of the apostle Paul, it is nevertheless a good general description of the servants and saved of God. One certainly needs to be saved in order to be a true servant of truth in all godliness.


Our Heavenly Father created each and every soul and His Word says we are Wonderfully Made! This includes each baby that is developing in the womb and each person on the earth.


