Mark 2:1-12

In this passage we find a paralyzed man upon a bed who was brought to Christ by

Dr. Caswell A. Reeves some friends. The Lord, who was speaking inside a house, was unapproachable because of all the people gathered to hear Him preach the word (v.2). The ingenious friends not caring what others thought and only interested in getting their friend to Christ went upon the roof and broke through the ceiling, lowering their friend into the presence of Christ.

Upon seeing the demonstration of their faith in Him for their friend, Jesus said, "Son, thy sins be forgiven thee" (v.5). Some in the crowd who heard this were critical of heart and thought it to be blasphemy. Yet, the Lord continued to instruct and despite their critical spirit, He healed the man of his palsy; who upon being healed, "arose, took up his bed, and went forth before them all" (12). This glorified God.

DEVOTIONAL CORNER

In this account, we learn a number of ingredients that can help us in our soul winning efforts. First, we need to set the stage for soul winning through preaching of the word and having a place like our local church to bring them.



GROW IN GRACE

How Many Times?

Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

Reflection: Does your child disrespect you? How many times should you give instruction to your child? Is your child used to hearing you ask 2, 3, 4, times or more before they comply? Have you heard parents threaten with empty words only to empower their children to continue in their rebellion? Children are amazingly brilliant and incredibly **trainable...**so their response at this point, most of the time, is a direct result of how they are trained.

It is entirely possible for children to do things the first time you ask and without argument. Often time parents make excuses for their child which does not help them to become obedient but instead trains them to make excuses for their bad behavior: I'm tired so I cannot obey, I don't feel good so I cannot obey, I didn't sleep well so I cannot obey, etc... Would the Lord receive these excuses from us at the judgment seat?

Should you try to be your child's best friend or is it your goal for your child to like you? Your Biblical responsibility is to train up your child to be obedient in the ways of the Lord and obeying parents is a Biblical principle. **DO NOT raise your voice** but show by example how you want them to speak. If they are not respectful to you, submissive to you, then that spills over to their attitude toward God. The Bible gives you all that you need to be the training parent the Lord wants you to be.

2 Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

2 Timothy 3:17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

Challenge: If this is already your pattern with your child, have a conversation and let them know that this will now be different. Tell them that your expectation is to say something once and that they must listen and obey immediately...then FOLLOW THROUGH with discipline if they transgress. Of paramount importance is this: BE CONSISTENT!!! I cannot emphasize this enough. Do what you say every time!!

Teach your child this verse and remind them of it when appropriate:

Colossians 3:20 Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

"Growing in Grace: A 12 Week Devotional for Women" Book 2


