a state of natural tranquility. Peace, harmony and concord between individuals.

It is clear from the Scripture that Jesus Christ is the author of peace. It was He that stilled the troubled sea and wind in Mark 4:39: And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. It is His gospel, which is called the Gospel of peace in Ephesians 6:15: And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; It was Jesus who was prophesied to bring peace to a troubled world in Luke 1:79: To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. It is Jesus who is called the son of peace in Luke 10:6: And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again.

Jesus Christ without question is the promoter of real heavenly peace. It is He that gives this heavenly peace as He declares in John 14:27: Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. This heavenly peace is unlike the peace of this world, which has a fleeting nature. Rather this peace is a lasting peace that can remove the worry and fear from the troubles that we have and must bear in this life. John 16:33 says, These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. This eternal peace to the soul comes when a person receives and trusts their life to the eternal keeping by Jesus Christ. We note that it is Jesus that made peace with God on our behalf, Romans 5:1: Therefore being justified by faith, we



have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

For the Believer this peace is indescribable and watches over our heart and mind as we read in Philippians 4:7: And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. As one of the fruits of the Spirit, Galatians 5:22: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, the Believer is expected to adorn this characteristic. It is notable that for the Believer, peace is an acceptable quality in their behavior. He is exhorted to follow peace in 2 Timothy 2:22: Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. And again in Hebrews 12:14: Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

Finally the Apostle Peter tells us who are Believers in 1 Peter 3:11, Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. And again in 2 Peter 3:14, he says, Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. Through Jesus Christ comes this wonderful peace. Do you have this peace and are you living in it? -CAR


John 14:27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
