Bible Baptist Theological Seminary began the eighth year of seminary courses for the training of pastors, missionaries, and church members to do the work of the ministry. Several new students have enrolled along with current seminarians to study the book of Jeremiah, the Gospel of Luke including medical language, and the book of Acts. The courses may be applied seminary degrees including the Master of Biblical Studies, the Master of Divinity, and the Doctor of Ministry. During these eight years of biblical and

theological instruction seminarians have enrolled in courses from the modules taught in Czech Republic, Dubai, Ireland, Korea, the Philippines, and Portugal. Seminary courses are also available on the BBC web site, and several area pastors enroll in the courses. BBC members are thankful for the impact that Bible Baptist Theological Seminary has had on pastors, missionaries, and churches around the world. Please continue to pray for this biblical endeavor.

Did not the Apostle Paul state, saying, "But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and **how shall they hear without a preacher**? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!" (Rom. 10:8-15)?

THE SAVED SERVANT TRUSTS IN THE VERACITY OF GOD



The Saved Servant Trusts in the Veracity of God

Dr. Caswell A. Reeves life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;"

In verse one, Paul gave a description of himself to Titus the recipient of the epistle. He also reveals the basis of what he is saying. In verse one, he gave two reasons for the basis of his authority or his position and practice. First, it is based upon the faith that all of God's children have – the faith that comes by the Scripture, which is referred to as the faith of God's elect. And second, it is based upon the truth or word of God, which is after godliness.

Now in verse two, Paul gives another reason for the basis of his authority or what he is saying. He states the reason is on the basis of hope of eternal life. In verse one, Paul employed the Greek preposition ($\kappa \alpha \tau \alpha$) or accordingly to introduce his first two reasons for what he believes and says. He now uses ($\epsilon \pi \iota$) or upon, which conveys the idea if on the basis of, or in accord with. So, Paul's reason is given upon the basis of hope of eternal life.

Paul employed the Greek word ($\epsilon\lambda\pi\iota\delta\iota$), which is translated hope. It refers to a real expectation of eternal life, which is based upon the ($\epsilon\pi\eta\gamma\gamma\epsilon\iota\lambda\alpha\tau\sigma$) promise or profession of God, and upon His integrity and character, that He cannot lie, and

upon His eternality, who promised before the world began (χ pov ω v) or before time. As a note of interest, the English word chronology comes from the Greek word (χ π pov ω v). It is translated world with the idea of before the creation of the world or time, as man knows it.

Certainly, Paul the servant of God and apostle of Jesus Christ is the immediate context, but in general any saved and serving Christian position is based upon faith, truth and the veracity of the promises and character of God.

Who Has The Rule?

Colossians 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the **power** of darkness, and hath translated us into the **kingdom of his dear Son**: (emphasis added)

Reflection: When reading this verse did you know that the word '**power**' means the following?

Power: power of choice, liberty of doing as one pleases

And in contrast the word **'Kingdom'** means this:

Kingdom: royal power, kingship, dominion, rule

This verse speaks to the easy believism of our day, the pray a prayer after me, the unchanged life of a professed Christian. Think about going to the bank, you desire to open a new account, therefore, you desire to close the one you have. To close this account you must transfer your money from one account to the other. The word **translate** means to 'transfer'.

Challenge: This verse is very clear that in salvation your loyalties have transferred from your own rule of your life to the authority, governing, control of and relationship with Jesus Christ. You cannot accomplish this in your own effort but it is the spiritual birth of being born-again. If you are still doing as you please and are the sole authority in your life, has your


first account truly been closed.

"Growing in Grace: A 12 Week Devotional for Women" Book 2


