#### **Ninth Annual Church Banquet**

On December 4, 2009, the Lord Jesus Christ started Bible Baptist Church with twenty-seven baptized church members from other area churches who signed the Bible Baptist Church Charter, Covenant, and Constitution. This year on December 9, 2018, Bible Baptist Church will celebrate her ninth anniversary as a NT assembly. A ham banquet will follow the AM service, with preaching and reminiscing for the 1:30 PM service.



# **DEVOTIONAL CORNER**

#### **Be Strong**

As the Apostle Paul closed his epistles to the church members of Corinth and Ephesus, he exhorted them to "be strong." In 1 Corinthians 16:13, he states "Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong."

He quotes from the Philistines, the enemies Israel, in 1 Samuel 4:9. The phrase carries the idea "to act like men." So, Paul encourages them to act like men (mature) and be strong. In Ephesians 6:10, He states, "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might." He directs them to be strong (to be strengthened) in the Lord. He qualifies this strengthening as that which is by the power of the Lord. The thought that is conveyed is that the church members were strongly exhorted to be dominated by the Lord's strength, His abilities and enablements. Paul's fellow laborer, Timothy was also exhorted to "be strong" by the Apostle Paul. In 2 Timothy 2:1, writing

his last epistle to Timothy, he states, "Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace of Jesus Christ." Timothy was to be strong, that is to find his strength in the unmerited blessings or benefits that were to be found in Christ Jesus his Savior. Moses in his writing reveals how the children of God were to be made strong that they might accomplish the life and tasks for which God desired of them. He shares with the Israelites in Deuteronomy 11:8, that the LORD states, "Therefore shall ye keep all the commandments which I command you this day, that ye may be strong, and go in and possess the land, whither ye go to possess it." The word "commandments" is equivalent to saying "words." In other words, they were to keep (quard and obey) all the words of God, because in doing this they would be made strong. The truth is strength comes from God's words. Christians in the New Testament have the responsibility to be strong and this strength still comes from the words of God. Therein is the reason and necessity to study your Bible and to learn it and to hide it in your heart, and to be strong in the Lord. -CAR

# What is Your Reputation?

Psalm 10:4 The wicked, through the pride of his his pre-conversion mindset when giving to, King countenance, will not seek after God: God is not Agrippa, his testimony: in all his thoughts.

Reflection: David expresses the reality that, in pride, man removes God from all his thoughts. The Lord is rejected, His ways are forsaken, and consequently His blessings are forfeited.

Our thoughts are extremely important in determining our emotions and our behaviour.

Proverbs 23:7a "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he..."

The words: thoughts, mind, and think, are mentioned well over 200x in the Bible. Our thoughts affect salvation, our walk with the Lord, and our service to Him. Our thoughts determine our direction toward the Lord or away from Him, a walk faithful to truth or a walk away from it, obedience to the Words of God or rebellion to His ways. We all have our opinions, what we think, and what we suppose to be true, Paul expressed

Acts 26:9 I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

At that point in time, he was a perfect example of Psalm 10:4, He was wicked, prideful, did not seek after God, nor was God in all his thoughts.

Challenge: Be intentional today regarding the thoughts you think. What do you notice: do your thoughts include the Lord? Are you on automatic and simply going about your day without Him? Train your mind to take your thoughts captive and cast down any thoughts that do not place the Lord first.


Now as we close out this wonderful year (With ladies wearing scarves made of cashmere) We praise the Lord for all members here.
