

Korea Trip Dr. Thomas Strouse



Dr. David Eum graciously invited me to preach in the Seoul First Baptist Church Bible Conference and also the Seoul First Baptist Theological Seminary graduation

service during the days of December 5-12, 2017. The Bible conference was well attended by church members and area

Dr. Thomas Strouse churches, as I dealt with the History, Doctrine, and Practice of the Ephesian Church. Several Korean men translated for my messages, including former Bible Baptist Church member Ohyun Kwon as well as Dr. Sam Yoon and Pastor Eum. On Sunday, December 10, 2017, I preached in the morning service of Seoul First Baptist Church and then preached and officiated in the Seoul First Baptist Theological Seminary commencement service with three men receiving seminary degrees. The Seminary graduates were Pastor Hyum Gyum Lee (BDiv),

Pastor Jae Ik Yang (MBS), and Dr. Suk Goo (Sam) Yoon (MBS).

The church housed me in the beautiful L'Art Hotel in downtown Seoul close to the church. Seoul is the capital of the Republic of Korea, and the metropolis contains the population of about 13,000,000, being the world's 17th largest city. Although there seems to be an increase in military presence as international tensions increase, the Korean Christians testify that they trust in the sovereign Lord Jesus Christ Who controls the nations, as Isaiah declared centuries ago, saying, "Behold, the nations are as

a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing" (Isa. 40:15). There is great peace for the Christian in the will of God, as Paul the Roman prisoner declared, saying, "Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7).

While in Korea several hosts took me sightseeing. For instance, one of the seminary graduates, Mr. Sam Yoon, took me to the Top Cloud restaurant on the 33rd floor of a skyscraper for a wonderful meal and then we visited and ascended the Seoul Tower. The Seoul Tower is 777 feet high and it sits upon the Namsan Mountain (797 ft.). I am glad that Solomon's observation about

aging only applies to the elderly, saying, "Also when they shall be afraid of that which is high..." (Eccl. 12:5). I also had coffee after the Commencement Service with Mr. and Mrs. Kwon and son Eun Hyeok and daughter Naeun, Mrs. Kwon's sister Hee Jeong and her mother, Mrs. Kim. On Monday I visited with recent seminary



graduate Dr. Sam Yoon, professor of thermodynamics at Korea University and fellow Purdue alumnus. Overall, I recognized that as Korean Christians face an uncertain future, they claim verses of protection and ultimate victory found in Hannah's prayer unto the LORD, saying "He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail. The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and he shall give strength unto his king, and exalt the horn of his anointed" (I Sam. 2:9-10).

H0w to Have Great Peace

How to Have Great Peace

Read: Matthew 18:21-35

³²Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me: ³³Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee? ³⁴And his lord was <u>wroth</u>, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him. ³⁵So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not <u>every one</u> his brother their trespasses. **Matthew 18:32-35**

Reflection: There is no greater example of forgiveness then that of the Lord Jesus Christ who became sin for us that we might be reconciled to the Father. Without the Lord Jesus, there would be no forgiveness of our sin. If you have not called on the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ to wash away your sins then you will die in your <u>sins</u> and will suffer eternal damnation.

In this account, the Lord is teaching Peter and His disciples about forgiveness. He is showing Peter that a lack of forgiveness is a condition of the heart. Our lack of forgiveness toward others shows a hypocrisy and a heart attitude that is in stark contrast to the heart of God. If He forgave us and we are the bottom of the wretched barrel, how can we then not forgive others whom the Lord is willing to forgive? Could we say that it is pride?

Challenge: How is the Lord speaking to you through this account? Does this account require that you take any action in your own heart and life? What specifically?


