### BIBLE BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY - DUBAI

During the days of Feb. 6-14, Dr. and Mrs. Thomas M. Strouse had a wonderful time ministering to the Baptist brethren in Dubai, UAE. After a long flight they arrived on the Muslim holy day of Friday and rested in the accommodating

Four-Star Atana Hotel. On Saturday, the second day of the weekend, the church held an ordination council for two men within the church who have the call and qualifications for the office of elder. These men have been trained in Bible Baptist Theological Seminary, being knowledgeable in Scripture and experienced in church work. Following the council examination, the biblical challenge by Dr. Strouse, and the laying on of hands by the council, the church members enjoyed a cookout with freshly-grilled goat and rice. On Sunday, the first day of the work week (through Thursday) Christians must go to church late on Sunday evening after eight-hour shifts to honor the Lord and His day of resurrection. Because of this "inconvenient hardship" many Christian churches and Baptists choose rather to worship earlier on Saturday, the last day of the weekend. Nevertheless, Bible Baptist Church of Dubai has determined to meet for the last twenty-one years at 8:00 PM until 10:00 PM for worship and fellowship, with many not getting home until after midnight, only to have to go to work or school the next day.

The fellowship among these committed church members is sweet as the congregation is led by the loving pastor and the gracious hosts, Pastor and Mrs. Flory Maloto. Dr. Emmanuel Tanierla, Bible Baptist Theological Seminary graduate, founded Bible Baptist Church of Dubai twenty-one years ago. The assembly has Bible studies in two other sites with the desire to establish these as churches, now that several men have submitted themselves for the pastoral ministry. Dr. Strouse has had the

privilege to preach at the villa in Dubai where the church regularly meets, as well as at the villa in Abu Dhabi for the Bible study, and at the rented room at the Holy Trinity facility for the Sunday PM church service. In the mean time, Dr. Strouse taught the course on Soteriology, or the doctrine of salvation which includes Hamartiology or the doctrine of sin and Anthropology or the doctrine of man.

During the day Dr. and Mrs. Strouse had the pleasure to do some sight-seeing, including view-

ing downtown Dubai from the Burj Khalifa (tallest building in the world) and shopping at the Mall of the Emirates (largest mall in the world [with an actual ski slope with snow]). On Tuesday they were invited to Zaya Nurai Island for din-



ner by the personal attaché of a multi-millionaire (in his absence), and saw what the wealth of the

world could buy and furnish for a resort home. Although the gold and silver of the world are impressive and perhaps tempting, the Christian has the promise of an eternal mansion (Jn. 14:2) in the New Jerusalem (Rev. 21:2-27) with glory and beauty far beyond imagination, as the Apostle Paul averred, saying, "But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him" (I Cor. 2:9; Isa. 64:4). On Wednesday the Strouses were treated to a trip to the Gold Souq (market) to view the vast wealth many shops had containing gold and silver. Of course Bible believers are looking forward to the promise of the precious Saviour Who revealed, saying, "And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass" (Rev. 21:21).

In January of 2021, Bible Baptist Theological Seminary plans to have its first seminary graduation with several seminarians as candidates for the Master of Biblical Studies (MBS). Bible Baptist Theological Seminary professors Dr. Thomas Strouse and Dr. Emmanuel Tanierla have taught at least ten different seminary modules to suffice for the seminarians to fulfill the required courses for graduation.

Proverbs 16:21: "The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips."


The heart that is froward finds no good

## **GROW IN GRACE DEVOTIONAL FOR WOMEN**

#### THE CONTRAST: 10,000 TALENTS AND 100 PENCE

Matthew 18:24 And when he had begun to transgressions committed against Him. We can reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

Matthew 18:28 But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants. which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

**Reflection:** It is important to note in this parable the incredibly wide difference between the debts owed.

I won't attempt to define how much 10,000 Talents or 100 Pence was equal to in today's monetary system but it should be very evident that numerically 10,000 is a whole lot more than 300 which truly reflected an immense debt that is owed to the Father in Heaven.

This parable teaches us that we cannot earn God's forgiveness for our innumerable never pay for our sin debt. It is our Lord and Saviour who took our sin upon Himself and loosed us from our transgressions.


Even as Jesus was on the cross as an innocent. sinless Lamb, He called upon His Father not to condemn those who were unjust to Him but to forgive them, so are we called to do:

Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.

Challenge: If the Lord has forgiven your 10,000 talents of sinfulness then should you not forgive your neighbor her offense of 100 pence? What gets in the way of you forgiving others? How do you know when you have forgiven? Is there someone you have offended? What will you do to make it right?
