THE CONVINCING WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 16:7-11

"Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."

From this passage, the Believer learns that the convincing work of the Holy Spirit is threefold. First, He reproves the world of sin. The word, "reprove" in the sense that it is used here, means to convict one of their sin. More than ever today there is a need that the unsaved man be able to see his sin and be convinced that He is a sinner before God. What is that sin that the Holy Spirit will reprove? It is not the sins that are so often thought of, but rather, it is the sin of not truly believing that Jesus the Son of God is the only one that can save a person from the penalty of their sin. It is important that the Believer realize that it is the job of the Holy Spirit to convince the lost of their unbelief, and that it is not the Believer's job; his job is only to declare the truth.

Second the convincing work of the Holy Spirit is to convince the lost men of the world of righteousness. Again, the Believer cannot do the work of the Holy Spirit in making an unsaved person see the righteousness of Jesus Christ for salvation, which is attested to by His resurrection and ascension. The Believer has two important truths to point out to the lost man: 1) That he is a sinner and 2) that Jesus Christ can save him. Convincing a person of these two important truths is the work of the Holy Spirit. And third, it is the convincing work of the Holy Spirit to convince men of the judgment. The Devil has been judged; it attests to the judgment of sin and of men. The world is not convinced of this truth, but nevertheless it is true, and it is the work of the Holy Spirit to convince the world that it will be judged.


There is another truth that is important to point out from this passage. It is the importance of the Believer. The Holy Spirit is the Comforter, He is the one who works with the Believer. In other words, it is through the Believer that the Holy Spirit convinces men of sin, righteousness and judgment. Simply, as Believers share the truth of God's Word with the unsaved of this world, the Holy Spirit will attempt to convince lost men of their need for Jesus Christ. When men are convinced, it is because the Holy Spirit did the convincing as men shared the truth. -CAR

BY STRENGTH OF HAND...THE LORD

Exodus 13:3 And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for **by strength of hand the LORD** brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened bread be eaten. (emphasis added)

4 And it shall be when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What is this? that thou shalt say unto him, **By strength of hand the LORD** brought us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage: (emphasis added)


Reflection: Do you remember Moses going to Pharaoh repeatedly to free the Israelites from bondage so they could be separated to serve the Lord? Pharaoh also repeatedly wanted Moses to compromise and do things in ways that fell short of complete separation.

Moses was faithful to the Lord and obeyed exactly what He said in this account. He did not compromise with Pharaoh. The Lord wants to be obeyed down to the detail of His Words anything short of that is sin.

Challenge: The Bible is our guide, it is the Lord's letter to us, it is His way. Is there anything that you have knowingly and willingly compromised? Do you take the Lord's written Word more seriously than you take any other thing in your life? Is the Lord calling you to be more faithful in a particular area?
