Jesus The Way

"Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. When I think about the time I received the Lord Jesus Christ as my Savior, I always think about this passage. It was these words of truth that the Holy Spirit used to pierce my heart and convince me that I had to put my trust solely and only in Jesus Christ the Son of God.

For years I went to church. I did learn about Jesus Christ and I did believe in Him in an intellectual way, as one would believe that George Washington was the United States' first President. However, my belief was not with my heart as God's word teaches.

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (Romans 10:9,10)

And while it is not a bad thing to believe in God and in His Son Jesus Christ, it is not enough to have a mental acknowledgement. As we learn from the Scripture, even the devils (demons) believe in God (James 2:19), but they are not going to heaven (Matthew 25:41).

Nevertheless, when I was shown (John 14:6), there was no question as to how one could get to the Father, who is in heaven. Jesus said, "I am the way...." This simply means that Jesus Christ is the ONLY WAY to go to heaven. If one adds anything else, such as: baptism, good works, church membership or even a sacrificial life of works; and he thinks these things will get him into heaven, he is denying "the truth" that gives "the life" which is in Jesus Christ "the way."



American Baptist preacher during the Civil War: The following is a quote from an address given at the Cove Hill Cemetery in Louisville, Kentucky, in May of 1886.



John Broadus

"Thank God that now all is peace! It is due partly to the mobile character of our people; partly to the ample resources of our great country, giving to all employment and hope, and partly, not withstanding all our imperfection and short coming, to the influence of Christianity. The great religion of peace has healed the wounds and softened the asperities of the great civil war."
