BBC Ordination Weekend Sept. 6 - 7






Commentary on I & II Timothy Coming Soon!

Abominable Pride

"Everyone that is proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord" (Proverbs 16:5).

When the Lord uses the word "abomination" it is referring to something or someone that is disgusting, and is an abhorrence to the character of godliness. The

proud or haughty person, the one who lifts himself above others in a contemptible attitude toward his fellows, this is the person God says is abominable to him. This is abominable pride.

As Christians, we are told: "The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate" (Proverbs 8:13). If God hates pride, then if we fear the Lord, we will hate pride. We understand, "the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom" (Proverbs 9:10). And with this wisdom we learn two things that pride brings. First, "when pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom" (Proverbs 11:2). And second, "only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom" (Proverbs 13:10).

We are warned that abominable pride is a destructive force. "Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall" (Proverbs 16:18). If God says it, then we can believe it. This kind of pride will bring us down. "A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit" (Proverbs 29:23).

God warns us and exhorts us against being proud in heart. He encourages us to be humble in spirit and to live in the wisdom of his word. "In the mouth of the foolish is a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them" (Proverbs 14:3). Jesus said, "that which cometh out of man, that defileth man. For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, murders, deceit, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man" (Mark 7:20-23). And finally, we are told within the context of a command not to love the world, "the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world" (1 John 2:15). Let us beware of the sin of abominable pride. -CAR
