DEVOTIONAL CORNER

A SOUND HEART

"A sound heart is the flesh of life."

Proverbs 14:30

What a statement, and God said it thousands of years ago. Today, doctors are still telling us the same truth. The medical community goes to great lengths to inform the public of things that are a risk to a healthy heart.

The heart, when referred to in scriptures, does not always refer to the physical organ. But rather to the place in man where the decisions of what he does in his life are made: "For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he" (Proverbs 23:7). That is why God warns us: "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life" (Proverbs 4:23).

One of those decisions, and a major one at that, is what you are going to do about your relationship with your God and Creator. Will you look for eternal life in Him: "And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart" (Jeremiah 29:13). And then will you receive God's gift of salvation: "And if thou...shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him [Jesus] from the dead, then thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness" (Romans 10:9-10).

Be careful of the heart, because it has a disingenuous nature. God warns: "The heart is deceitful above all things and desperately wicked: who can know it" (Jeremiah 17:9). Many times the heart acts upon what it sees and feels rather than upon what is true. And that is why we are told of the certainty and power of God's Word over the heart. "There are many devices in a man's heart; nevertheless the counsel of the Lord, that shall stand" (Proverbs 19:21). Discipline your heart to do what the Word of God says, because it is "truth" (John 17:17).

A sound heart (organ) is good for the physical body. So also, a sound heart (the spiritual center of man's will) is good for the spiritual and eternal life of man. Therefore, "keep thy heart with all diligence." (Proverbs 4:23). -CAR

Ephesians 2:4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his


