Dr. Thomas M. Strouse

Turing the week of July 22-26, 2019, Dr. Thomas Strouse taught the module on the seminary course entitled Minor Prophets II, covering these six prophets in chronological order, namely, Nahum, Zephaniah, Habakkuk,

Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi. Good friend and seminary doctoral graduate, Dr. Chet Kulus, along with his hospitable wife Nancy were the hosts for Dr. Strouse. The class was well attended with 16 students.

n interesting verse covered during the week was the following: "Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger" (Zeph. 2:3). Zephaniah's name means "Jehovah hath hidden," and the prophet encouraged the remnant believers to carry on Josiah's reformation for blessing (cf. 1:1). The LORD promised through him that those that seek and

trust in Jehovah would be hid when catastrophe came. The NT saint is hid in Christ, as Paul declared, saying, "For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God" (Col. 3:3). When the Tribulation comes, the believer who is hid in Christ, will be safe, protected, and delivered, as John revealed, saying, "Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth" (Rev. 3:10). Are you in Christ? If so, you are hid in Christ!

#### ALL FLESH SHALL COME

Psalm 65:2 "O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come"

We live in a day in which there are many who doubt whether there is a God. This is not something that is exclusive to our day only. For centuries there have been many who have doubted God's existence. That is why God has given to man promises, very


impossible tasks which only He can do, in order to prove "that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:6).

One of those promises which was an impossible task is the birth of Christ: "Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold a virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel" (Isaiah 7:14). This promise was given to clearly identify God's only savior to the world. And that this savior was heaven sent. Thus, the virgin birth of Jesus Christ.

God has also given us a promise with hope: Psalm 65:2. Therefore, as we live amongst the ungodly and unbeliever and the blasphemer, we may know that one day all flesh will come before Him. This promise is again reiterated; "And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith the Lord" (Isaiah 65:23). Again, God says: "As I live saith the Lord, every knee shall bow unto me, and every tongue shall confess to God" (Romans 14:11). And with striking detail, we are told, "that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:10-11).

Have you confessed Christ as your Savior? One day you will. What will he say to you? Will you hear him say, "Well done, thou good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21), or will you hear him say, "I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity" (Matthew 7:23).
