DEVOTIONAL CORNER



The Art of Giving

Acts 20:35

"It is more blessed to give than to receive"

Give according to God's Word. The art of giving always starts by trusting the Lord. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart; and lean not into thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him and he shall direct thy paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6). The word "paths"


Pastor Cas Reeves literally means "road" and figuratively is understood as "way of life." This can include your giving. True help in understanding "giving" comes when you totally commit yourself to the Lord. This gives priority to the words of God rather than human reasoning, and especially helps when you are considering what to give.

You give by first trusting the Lord. Paul spoke of the accomplishment in giving by the brethren in Macedonia when he said, "I bear record, yea, and beyond their power [ability] they were willing of themselves; praying we would receive the gift and this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God" (2 Corinthians 8:3-5).

You should give to those who can't give back. Jesus said, "Thou shalt be blessed; for they can't recompense thee: for thou shalt be recompensed at the resurrection of the just" (Luke 14:14). So, we learn that charitable giving is not to be paid back. It is a giving with a future and heavenly reward. Don't give in order to receive. When you give, give your all in grateful worship. Note the account of the Samaritan leper, who Christ healed, who "fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks" (Luke 17:16). From this act of giving we learn, one can give in a spirit of worship and gratitude. Simliar, is the maniac of Gadara, who wanted to give himself to Jesus. And he "prayed him that he might be with him" (Mark 5:18). This man was willing to give all of himself. Likewise, we should also.

Finally, you should give to God through your local church. God has chosen to finance his work through His people. Pointedly, he has not chosen to finance his church by secular activities used by secular organizations (raffles, bingo, rummage sales, etc), but rather by the tithes and offerings of His people. "Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house" (Malachi 3:10a). By doing this God can also bless His people. Notice God's challenge, "and prove me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing" (Malachi 3:10b). So prove God and let God receive the "glory in the church" for your giving, as you first give yourself to the Lord Jesus (Ephesians 3:21). Let God bless you in your giving! -CAR

I SHALL NOT WANT

Ye shall not surely die:

5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

Reflection: Can we ever exhaust learning from the account of Adam and Eve?

The Bible describes Satan as an accuser, full of lies, malice, and subtil, which is to say shrew and sly. He is far above our intelligence and has had several thousand years to study how mankind is wired, what we crave, what we desire, how we covet, and how to trip us up.

The heart of David expresses his satisfaction and contentment and reliance on the LORD as shepherd of his soul. Can you say that you shall not want?

Genesis 3:4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Psalm 23:1 (A Psalm of David.) The LORD [is] my shepherd; I shall not want.

> Mankind is never satisfied, nor content. The pattern is the same throughout generations beginning in this account with Adam and Eve, to whom the LORD provided everything they could possibly desire. But even in perfection...Adam and Eve had thoughts that led to **emotions** that then led to **action**. We are now experiencing the effects of these thoughts, and we are not immune to continuing the same pattern. We may desire to walk in the Spirit, we may grow in our walk in the Spirit, but Satan and his demons are there to effect continually the thoughts we think which cause the choices we make. I wonder if this is why we are continually told to be mindful of our thoughts. Our defeat begins in the mind!

> Challenge: Be honest, does the Lord satisfy your every desire? Pay attention to what you need today in addition to the Lord. What in your life besides the Lord can you not do without? Does the Lord Jesus Christ satisfy your every longing or do you still need to supplement with the ways of the world for your satisfaction?
