

n December 4, 2009, the Lord led Dr. Thomas M. Strouse, Dean of Emmanuel Baptist Theological Seminary, to leave Emmanuel Baptist Church, Newington, CT, and start a New Testament assembly in Cromwell, CT. Several families decided to follow his leadership and constituted together Bible Baptist Church of Cromwell, CT. The charter membership included 27 church members from several area Baptist churches who covenanted together before the Lord the carry out the


Pastor Strouse presented a brief history of BBC, August Gagnon read the 13th Anniversary Poem, and Andrew Williams challenged us from the Word of God.

PREFACE

"Keep yourselves from Idols"

A Commentary on the Johannine Epistles

The Lord Jesus Christ through His Scripture gives prominence to the church started at Ephesus. Four books of the Bible specifically addressed the Ephesian assembly, namely *The Epistle to the Ephesians*, *First and Second Timothy*, and the *Apocalypse*. Moreover, Paul spent three years at Ephesus and later instructed the Ephesian Elders at Miletus. Scripture revealed and the patristics testified that the Apostle John lived in the area of Ephesus. Gnosticism was the heretical backdrop of the first century as every New Testament book dealt with the Lies of the Garden either directly or indirectly. The apostle of love knew the Lord Jesus Christ and ministered with and for Him, defending His Person and work from the ubiquitous attack upon his true Deity and Humanity.

Because of this common theme in the *Gospel of John*, the *Epistles of John*, and the *Apocalypse*, this commentator has assumed that the apostle's writings give the history of the Ephesian assembly from the reception of the *Gospel*, through the reception of the three successive *Epistles*, culminating with the threat of loss of candlestick status in the *Book of Revelation*. The history of the Ephesian Baptist Church covered the period from the mid-fifties to the mid nineties of the first century, or over forty years. The known pastors then were Aquinas, Paul, Timothy, John, Gaius, the deceiver Diotrophes, and Demetrius. The last pastor received the challenge to repent or lose candlestick status. Today, the church is gone.

The exegesis of the Greek text of the *Johannine Epistles* was great joy to this commentator. On several occasions, I taught the Greek text of the books to Bible Baptist Church membership. The promise that the precious Lord gave about knowing all things because of His indwelling was surely a reality to this commentator, and to all who desire the indwelling Divine Author and Teacher to teach His inspired Books! I am thankful for the prayers and support of Bible Baptist Church members. Especially am I thankful for my dear wife Jan of fifty-six years who is always a blessing and helpmate.

Starting January 30, 2023

The Bible and Madness PS 620 (Monday, 6-9 PM)

Dr. M. Ryan Strouse will teach the course on the Bible and Madness, following his soon to be released Primer on Biblical Madness. This will be an excellent study on the current madness in which the present generation is entrapped. Both pastors and church member will benefit from the analysis of and suggested help for Mental Illness that this course will provide. The era of the sixties in which this Seminary Dean lived knew nothing about the current labels and pharmaceutical prescriptions for every type of affliction in the world and among Christians in post-Christian America. Normative Christian living back then was faithful service to the Saviour in the local church, studying Scripture, praying, and ministering to sinners with the Gospel while enjoying the will of God. Not so today among Christians! This seminary course from one knowledgeable about Scripture and experienced in the medical field will attempt to deal with the following:

1. To Reveal the Biblical precedent for physical nourishment and care of those suffering the varying forms of madness; however, the remedy and cure for madness is always spiritual.

2. To Understand "Mental Illness" or Madness from a Biblical and compassionate perspective.

3. To Connect Biblical forms of madness to modern diagnostic labels.

4. To Recognize that all individuals (saved and unsaved) have a proclivity toward a form of "Madness" in the flesh.

5. To Acknowledge that Madness is a spiritual issue (mind), not a physical problem in the brain.

6. To Distinguish between Valid Brain Disease (Alzheimer, Dementia, Autism, Aging, etc.) and Madness (Schizo, Bipolar, Anxiety, Depression).


7. To Equip believers with historical origins of modern psychology, with the discernment of psychological terms and diagnosis from a biblical perspective, and with modern research that rebuffs the mainstream theories.

8. To suggest the biblical interventions of compassionate care in the Word of God, including repentance and faith in Christ and the sufficiency of Christ and His Word.

Greek I BL 601 and Greek V BL 605 (Thursday 6-9 PM)

Dr. Thomas M. Strouse will teach Biblical Greek for beginners as well as for pastors who want a refresher course. Also, those who have taken two years of Greek and want to exegete a biblical Greek passage and write a running commentary on the passage and then present it in class every week may meet simultaneously
