IS THE PASTOR THROUGHLY FURNISHED?

The Apostle Paul says "Yes" and the "Mystical, Invisible, Universal, Ghost Church" devotees say "No"! The Apostle to the Gentiles instructed his understudy Timothy about the only available divine defense against the "perilous times" in which men "wax worse and worse" (II Tim. 3:1-5, 13). He averred, saying, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for

doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." (II Tim. 3:16-17). Since the Bible consists of the Words of God, it is profitable for the man of God (i.e., pastor) to teach doctrine, to reprove sinners and saints, to correct wayward mankind, and to instruct all in righteous living. Paul said that the biblical pastor with the Word of God "may be perfect" (artios [1x]), complete or fit. Moreover, he claimed using the perfect passive participle that the pastor has been and still is "throughly furnished" (exartizo [2x]). The Bible is the heavenly textbook sufficiently and singularly adequate for the pastor to deal with all of the challenges in a fallen world with the adamic nature of men open to "the wiles of the devil" (Eph. 6:11).

The "Ghost Church" presents a plethora of "gurus" or "experts" who think that they can help "the poor, weak, insignificant pastor who can hardly stumble through his well-worn *KJV* biblical text and make sense of it." These experts usually receive Bible college training from para-church Bible colleges or seminaries and continue to promote the "Ghost Church" heresy. Quite often, they have received training in foisting the American business model on church ministry and practice. Many of these devotees have started their own para-church ministries or they work through para-church mission boards based on pragmatic business models and focus on a "niche" in which they become "experts." With their niche of expertise, they may claim to be the biblical counseling expert, the biblical financing expert, the revivalist expert, the creationist expert, the legal expert, the PTSD expert, the children's ministry expert, the outreach expert, the church growth expert, the

missions expert, or the church "watchdog" expert. Although there is a place for pastors to be knowledgeable scripturally about the aforementioned topics, can they use the Scriptures to minister to the sinners of society and the saints of the congregation? The experts say "*No*"! They need the gurus of para-church ministries to help them navigate through their church challenges with the vast wisdom of the "experienced scholars" and unlimited resources of the Ghost Church. Although some may claim that their para-church ministry is supported by a local church, if the income and budget of the ministry are not included within the church budget, then it is functioning with financial and theological autonomy and is a separate entity. A church has its own financial budget, and a para-church has its own budget, and nary they come together!

Obviously, there is a place for sister churches of like faith to share resources in terms of the teaching and counseling by trained men, of the facilities, and of the ministries. This biblical sharing of church personnel is far different than subscribing to utilizing para-church ministries with the "experts" outside of biblical ecclesiology "helping" biblical assemblies! In effect, these gurus say that the Lord's Baptist assemblies are insufficient, and as well, that the Word of God is insufficient for the pastors of these biblical churches. Assuredly, pastors can use helps such as commentaries, lexicons, electronic Hebrew and Greek sources, internet searches, etc., in their study of the Word of God. But do they need the Ghost church salesman who pitches his expertise to remedy the supposed fact that biblical pastors are nonthoroughly furnished?

Pastors, why support theologically and financially the para-church gurus fostered by the Ghost Church when the Lord has given you all you need in your visible assembly with the Scriptures? The precious Lord loves His assemblies, and He loves His pastors by giving them the sufficient Words of God. Certainly, the pastor needs to study the Scriptures and make applications for all challenges within and without the assembly. When Paul left the Ephesian Baptist Church elders, Scripture states his farewell, saying, "And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified" (Acts 20:32).

Are you "throughly furnished" to do the work of the Lord? Who says so?


