COMMENCEMENT MESSAGE

JEREMIAH 26:1-24

PREMISE: *The Man of God* ministers with the Word of the LORD to do the Work of the LORD in the Will of the LORD.

Background:

Josiah (641-609 BC) > Jehoahaz (609 BC) > Jehoiakim (606 -597 BC): Temple message (cf. Jer. 7:3 > 26:13) > "Amend your ways" > 609 > 605 > 597 > 586 BC

I. The WORD of the Lord (vv. 1-6)

- A. The Place of the Word (vv. 1-2b) > Temple > 3-fold repetition (Jer. 7:4)
- B. The Preaching of the Word (vv. 2c-5) > diminish not Dt. 4:2 > 12:32 > Prov. 30:6 > Rev. 22:18-19
- C. The People of the Word (v. 6) > "this house" (Jer. 7:10, 11, 14) like Shiloh > (I Sam. 4:10; Ps. 78:60)

II. The WORK of the Lord (vv. 7-19)

- A. It Requires Dedication to the Lord (vv. 7-9) > Shiloh? Warranted death!
- B. It Raises Difficulties in the Lord (vv. 10-11) > he should die > hate preacher of word
- C. It Reaffirms Determination for the Lord (vv. 12-15) > I can't be bought out > truth not for sale! > whose words will win out? > Jer. 44:28!
- D. It Receives Defense from the Lord (vv. 16-19) > Micah 3:12 delivered him!

III. The WILL of the Lord (vv. 20-24)

- A. The Responses (vv. 20-21)
 - 1. Flee the Geographical Will of the Lord (vv. 20-23) > Jonah syndrome
 - a. Urijah ("Jehovah my light")
 - b. Influenced by Jeremiah against city and land
 - c. Jehoiakim wanted to kill him
 - d. Urijah left the geographical will of God > Egypt! (left place of truth!)
 - e. Urijah suffered tragedy outside of Geographical Will (so did Jonah)
 - 2. Follow the Geographical Will of the Lord (v. 24) > Jeremiah and Ahikam
- B. Result (vv. 23-24)
 - 1. Fleeing the Will of God has Problems (v. 23) > disobedience leads to death
 - 2. Following the Will of God gives Protection (v. 24) > obedience leads to blessing > Dt. 30:19
- *Application: The Lord has a will for Man of God who must resist money, fame, family, relatives, bigness, or other things to tempt him to leave the will of God.


CONCLUSION: You are trained men who have advanced to this level of biblical knowledge: **Do not leave the will of God.** Lord wants to use you!
