

NEW HAMPSHIRE MODULE



Dr. Thomas M. Strouse

During the week of July 25-29, 2022, Dr. Thomas Strouse taught the module on "The Geography and Commentary of Paul's Prosperous Journey." The class was well attended by church members, and Dr. and Mrs. Chet Kulus were gracious hosts providing fellowship and food during the week. Dr. Kulus, pastor of Calvary Independent Baptist Church of Plymouth, NH, has ministered in this biblically sound church for many years. The module dealt with Paul's spiritually prosperous trip from Troas

to Rome, initially encouraging the Ephesian Baptist Church elders, then beaten at Jerusalem, imprisoned at Caesarea, endangered by the typhoon Euroclydon, snake-challenged at Malta, and incarcerated at Rome. Along the way the Apostle Paul preached the Gospel to the Jews and Gentiles, met with church members in different locations, some of whom he had probably

previously persecuted, ministered to some 276 sailors and prisoners on board a ship, and indoctrinated the Maltese barbarians and planted the Malta Baptist Church. Paul reached Rome as he desired (Rom. 1:10-11) and as the Lord promised (Acts 23:11) via a spiritually prosperous journey, albeit strewn with great dangers.

WHAT IS FAITH?

TEXT: Hebrews 11:1-10

aith is belief in its simplest form of understanding. It is defined in the Bible as "...the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). This more

technical definition of faith reveals that our faith is the substance or confidence we have in something or someone which we cannot see but believe that is there (hope for). As well, faith is the evidence or practices (Greek pragma from which we get the English word pragmatic) of things not seen or without evidence by sight.


X 7 hen you believe in God, who you cannot see, you are revealing your confidence or the substance of your faith. When you put your faith to work or practice your faith in God (by receiving what He says, receiving His Son, praying, going to church) you are showing the evidence of your faith.

The faith that God is pleased with produces in you a good report or testimony (11:2). It gives you an understanding about the creation of all things (11:3). It causes you to obtain righteousness (11:4). It gives you favor with God (11:5-6). It can aid in the salvation of your family (11:7). It causes obedience to God and gives a real and lasting inheritance (11:8). It causes you to look for heaven (11:9-10).

Do you have this kind of God pleasing faith?


