Text: Psalm 3

One of the greatest things that I have seen as a saved man is how God blesses His people in a continual manner as they walk with Him throughout their life. Many times this continual blessing of God, is referred to by us as 'the good life.'

The Psalmist states there are many that mock our God and us (1). They rise up against us and tell us that God is not our help (2). Yet the Psalmist declares, that the LORD is our shield, the One in whom we can take refuge behind. As does a child behind his mother's skirt or as a soldier does behind his shield of armor so is the LORD our shield (3). The Lord is our glory or honor (3); He is the One who lifts us up with His strength (3), the One from whom all our blessings flow. It is He whom we call upon in our joy and distress and it is He who hears our prayers from His heavenly abode (4). Truly, we are privileged.


The Psalmist reveals that it is the LORD that awakens us and sustains us on a daily basis. That it is He that gives us rest and protects us in that rest and causes us to rise again each day of our lives (5). And as well, He sustains us with breath to breathe and food to eat. Truly He is our Sustainer (5). He has removed the fear of our enemies, regardless of their strength and given us great boldness through His strength that we might declare, 'I will not be afraid.' (6)

Yes, it is the LORD who is our salvation to whom we can call in our moment of need (7). It is He that is the victorious One over our enemies and troubles. It is to Him that salvation belongs and to whom His people are so blessed (8). -CAR
