EXPANDED SUMMARY FOR SONG OF SOLOMON

PREMISE: What would it be like to be King Solomon's true love? The Shulamite and Solomon met in their respective vineyards and "fell in love." The couple carried on their pure relationship, re-enacting Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. This was the LORD's original plan. Although passages are explicit, even embarrassing and awkward for the western reader, Solomon's literature was read publicly to his congregation of families!

Title (1:1)

A. Their Anticipated Passion for Love (vv. 1:2-2:7)

The Shulamite (S-L-M) met a stranger while attending her stepbrothers' vineyards and fell in love with this handsome stranger. She fantasized about marrying him and the wedding night! Solomon's women (60 queens and 80 concubines and virgins) didn't know who the lover was! Solomon (S-L-M) wanted her as well, as a true love, not a forced political marriage (even with Naamah, mother of Rehoboam [I Ki. 14:31])!

B. Their Anticipated Passion in the Garden (vv. 2:8-17)

They anticipated their love on the wedding night in the outside field/garden where they met.

C. Her Active Passion in Searching for her Lover (vv. 3:1-5)

Not knowing that this was the king Solomon, she searched for him to no avail.

D. Their Accomplished Passion in the Garden (vv. 3:6-5:1)

Nevertheless, they planned on marriage and the particular day. Instead of a simple "field worker" showing up on the wedding day, the throne chariot of Solomon showed up with sixty guards to take her to the wedding chamber. Who am I in love with?—it's Solomon! They declared their descriptive love for each other. On the wedding night a Third Party encouraged them to participate in marital love! Who was this third party? Jehovah, Who gave the marriage contract—leave, cleave, weave (Gen. 2:24)?!

ARTICLE CONCLUSION

C.' Her Active Passion in Searching for her Lover (vv. 5:2-7:11)

King Solomon had kingly duties and left, and she couldn't find him.

B.' Their Actual Passion in the Garden (vv. 7:12-8:4)

But he would visit her again where they continued their love in the "garden" (cf. 4:12 [6x]).

A.' Their Actual Passion in Love (vv. 8:5-14)

They met where Bathsheba conceived Solomon to solemnize his birth as Jedidiah, memorializing the "cycle of life" The Shulamite wanted to be Solomon's most prized possession as a seal on his heart and arm. She contrasted two emotions: love and jealousy which parallel death and grave. They would experience all four. The couple had a younger sister who needed to be a wall and not a door, morally. The Shulamite had kept her vineyard/garden (body) and desired him to visit her again!
