MINISTRY IN KOREA

On December 7, 2023, Dr. Thomas M. Strouse and Mr. August Gagnon traveled to Seoul Korea to participate in the Commencement Service of Seoul Baptist Bible College and Seminary under aegis of Seoul First **Baptist** Church. Pastor David Eum officiated in the service and conferred one bachelor's degree and four master's degrees to the candidates. The men are either currently pastoring or pastors in training. Mr. D. Im received the bachelor's degree, and the following received the master's, including J. Park, J. Yoo, K. Kim, and Y. Choi. One of these men (identity undisclosed), now pastoring in Seoul, escaped the threat of death for helping North Korean dissidents. All Christianity in North Korea is underground, and exposed Christians are usually executed or severely tortured. There are efforts to smuggle Bibles and Gospel materials underground. Soft American Christianity and Baptists know little about nor care to consider the Apostle John's exhortation, "Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren" (I Jn. 3:16). Pray for these men and others who are called to minister to Koreans, whether in North or South Korea! What are you doing with your life?

On Monday, Dr. Strouse and brother August visited the campus of University

of Korea and Dr. Yoon, mechanical engineer from Purdue University, the engineering alma mater of Dr. Strouse. On Tuesday night Dr. Strouse preached on "the Doctrine and Practice of

the Local Church" with former Bible Baptist Church member Ohyun Kwon translating the message. Afterward, he had the special privilege to meet



Pastor Jaebeon Lee who has spent three years translating Dr. Strouse's book *I Will Build My Church* into the Korean Language. On Wednesday night, Dr. Paul Lee attended, who was one of Dr. Strouse's first Korean seminarians 43 years ago, and who also received his doctorate from Dr. Strouse in 2003. Dr. Strouse spoke on "The Second Coming of Christ" with Dr. Yoon translating. During the week, Dr. Strouse had the privilege of reuniting with former graduate of Pastor Eum's Seminary, Pastor Jae Ik Yang (no relation to Yin).

We are thankful for Pastor David Eum and his church and seminary, winning sinners to the Lord, edifying the saints, and training men for the pastoral ministry. Pastor Eum also headed up the effort to translate from the Hebrew and Greek of the KJV into the Korean equivalent the KJV, with thousands published.
