"KJV" BAD!

INTRODUCTION

Recently, in American politics the mantra "Orange Man Bad" circulated through the public arena and seemed to catch on among the younger and generally politically naïve. Why is "Orange Man Bad"? Who knows? Everyone is saying it (primarily the media),

and so it must be true! Who knows and who cares? "Orange Man Bad"! In a far more important and spiritually impactful arena, the mantra "KJV BAD" has surfaced among the spiritual neophytes of recent Bible college graduates, of former disgruntled fundamentalists, and of pretentious "scholars" of the Bible within and without New Testament assemblies. Why is "KJV BAD"? Who knows and who cares? It must be true that "KJV BAD" because after all, everyone says it is bad! Therefore, in making the exclamatory claim "KJV BAD," the neophytes cause immediate shame and guilt to fall on the recipients of the condemnation "KJV BAD!" Has anyone making this claim given biblical reasons for the gnomic expression "KJV BAD"? Is there any godly or theological merit in shaming, ridiculing, and even excoriating those devout believers who desire to use the KJV in personal and corporate study and worship?

Who knows and who cares?

EXAMINATION OF "KJV BAD"

Is the "KJV BAD" because it declares the Christological truth of the eternal Sonship of the Lord Jesus, saying, "No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him" (Jn. 1:18)? Whereas the verb "to beget" and adjective "only begotten" always refer to the father-son relationship throughout Scripture (cf. Gen. 5:3 ff.). However, the NASV promotes the Arian heresy that Jesus is a "begotten god," saying, "No man has seen God at any time; the only begotten God, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained Him." The neophyte darling ESV fares no better, rendering with translational gobbledygook the elimination of the Son, "No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known."

Who knows and who cares?

"KJV" BAD

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Is the "KJV BAD" because it declares the great truth of the incarnation of God in the person of Jesus of Nazareth, saying, "And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh..." (I Tim. 3:16)? The "great and mighty" ESV posits the Gnostic rendering of the denial the incarnation, reading, "Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh." How about the former darling NIV: "Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body..." The NASV had to straighten the English grammar of their ungrammatical Greek text with the following, "And by common confession great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh." How profound! We are manifest in the flesh—that is no mystery!

Who knows and who cares?

Is the "KJV BAD" because it gives the clearest theological statement in all of the Bible about the Trinity, saying, "For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one" (I Jn. 5:7). The Gnostic-laced Greek Critical Text behind all modern versions rejects the inspired Trinitarian formula, such as the NET: "For there are three that testify" (I Jn. 5:7); and the ESV: "For there are three that testify" (I Jn. 5:7); and the NASV: "And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is the truth" (I Jn. 5:7); and the NIV: "For there are three that testify" (I Jn. 5:7); and the RSV: "And the Spirit is the witness, because the Spirit is the truth" (I Jn. 5:7). Not one of the modern versions built upon the Critical Text has the inspired Trinitarian passage.

Who knows and who cares?

Is the "KJV BAD" because it has the full New Testament Greek Text (Received Text) whereas the modern versions such as the ESV, NASV, NET, NIV, et al, have omitted or changed about 7% of the Greek Critical Text? It may be easily demonstrated that the Critical Text behind the modern darlings of new translations is Gnostic-laced because it omits key passages defending the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Who knows and who cares?

Is the "*KJV* BAD" because it is built upon the scriptural promises of God to preserve His inspired words perfect for excellent translations in all languages (Pss. 12:6-7; 119:152; Prov. 30:5-6; Mt. 24:35)? The editors of the Critical Text have maintained that the Lord never promised the preservation of His words and in fact did not preserve them, but He expects the gurus of textual criticism to restore and reconstruct (*sic*) what the Lord purposefully did not preserve!
