### THE NON-PRESERVATION OF THE INSPIRED AND PERFECT WORDS OF THE LORD!

We staunch defenders of the received texts of the Hebrew and Greek texts behind the venerable King James Bible have to admit that not all of the inspired and perfect words of the Lord Jesus Christ have been preserved. Therefore, it falls upon us to ask several questions with regard to these words which came from the Lord Jesus but that we do not have. Should we try to restore what God has providentially determined not to preserve? Should we use the best techniques available to come close to restoring these perfect words? What would be the authority to pursue this worthy effort? Did the Lord ever declare or hint at the responsibility that man must restore what the Lord God determined not to preserve? Finally, who in our company of defenders has the intelligence, skill, knowledge, methodology, and esteem to take on such a daunting task?

For instance, there is a passage in Scripture in which the Lord wrote inspired and perfect words which have not been preserved. The account occurs in the *Gospel of John* when the Lord wrote with His finger certain words. The Scripture states, "*But Jesus stooped down, and with his finger wrote on the ground…again he stooped down, and wrote on the ground*" (Jn. 8:6, 8). What were the words that came from the Son of God, and therefore were inspired and consequently perfect with no misspellings, or grammatical, or historically errors, that the perfect Saviour wrote? These words have not been preserved! Should we attempt to restore the perfect words of God that He purposefully determined not to preserve?

The editor of the *NET*, Dr. Daniel Wallace, international scholar and expert of restoring the original Greek text that Jehovah purposefully did not preserve, states about the text, saying, "it can also be interpreted as implying that what Jesus wrote was a counteraccusation against the accusers (although there is no clue as to the actual content of what he wrote, some scribes added 'the sins of each one of them' either here or at the end of v. 8)." Others posit that the Lord may have written "thou shalt not commit adultery" (Ex. 20:14). Maybe the Lord wrote down the names of the adulterers in the group; whose names should we suggest? Is there no way to tell what the Lord wrote? Of course some state that there is no issue here because the so-called *pericope adulterae* is not in the earliest and best Greek manuscripts (*sic*). The note in *The Ryrie Study Bible* on Jn. 7:53-8:11 asserts that "this story, though probably authentic, is omitted in many manuscripts and may not have been originally a part of this Gospel." It is obvious that the best of the best of the best of textual scholars cannot with any certainly restore the inspired words of God which He purposefully did not preserve!

For we who believe that the Lord Jesus Christ did promise to preserve His perfectly inspired words (Ps. 12:6-7; 119:152; 160; Mt. 24:35; *et al*), for which we are accountable (Jn. 12:48), and in fact did fulfill His promise to preserve His perfect words, can find solace in that we do not know what He wrote in the ground and that we are not responsible or accountable for *these words*, by which we are to live but cannot (Mt. 4:4)! We have the promises of Scripture about perfect words preservation; the critics have no promises and can only deny the promises that we have! Let us focus on the inspired and perfect words that the Lord has given us, and live thereby.
