OT PRAYER

Occasions for Old Testament Prayer

Various situations in the lives of OT saints occasioned them to pray. Here are some of them.

- 1. Prayer for divine honor: "LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word. 37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again" (I Ki. 18:36-37).
- **2. Prayer for vision:** "And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha" (Il Ki. 6:17).
- **3. Prayer of longer life:** "I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore" (II Ki. 20:3).
- **4. Prayer for spiritual prosperity:** "And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested" (I Chr. 4:10).
- **5. Prayer for giving:** "Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all" (I Chr. 29:12).
- **6. Prayer for reform:** "And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD is with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you" (II Chr. 15:2).
- 7. Prayer with fasting: "Then I proclaimed a fast there, at the river of Ahava, that we might afflict ourselves before our God, to seek of him a right way for us, and for our little ones, and for all our substance" (Ezra 8:21).
- **8. Prayer in an emergency:** "Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make request? So I prayed to the God of heaven" (Neh. 2:4).
- **9. Prayer for courage:** "For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?" (Est. 4:14).
- **10. Prayer for a mediator:** "For he is not a man, as I am, that I should answer him, and we should come together in judgment. Neither is there any daysman betwixt us, that might lay his hand upon us both" (Job 9:32-33).

Success in Serving

"This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to

Pastor Cas Reeves all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success"

Joshua 1:8

God spoke these words to Joshua as he was beginning his role of leadership in serving the Lord and leading God's people into the Promised Land. We can just imagine how Joshua must have felt as he assumed this mantle of great responsibility. It must have been a time of great personal introspection, and those times are fearful. However, we note that God is there to bring assurance: "Be strong and of good courage" God says as He reiterates to Joshua his mission. "Only be strong and very courageous" as He speaks about the character of His servant's service. And finally as He commands, "Be strong and of good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou successful in the Word. -CAR

dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest" (Joshua 1:6-9).

We note that God promised Joshua success; "There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee" (Joshua 1:5). The key to this success is found in (Joshua 1:8) the "book of the law" [the Bible] and what Joshua was supposed to do with it. He was to know it; "shall not depart out of thy mouth." He was to understand it; "meditate therein day and night." And he was to obey it; "observe to do according to all that is written therein."

By application, just as Joshua was encouraged from God's Word, so we are encouraged. The Apostle Peter encouragingly points us toward successfulness in our service to the Lord, when he says, "Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you. Be sober be vigilant" (1 Peter 3:6-8). Here, Peter detailed biblical activities for our personal success: 1) Humility, 2) Dependence, 3) Seriousness and 4) Vigilance.

The Psalmist of old said, "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night" (Palm 1:1-2). The Psalmist knew, that being successful in service meant being
