Evolutionists such as astrophysicist Sir Fred Hoyle said: "We know that the difference between a heliocentric theory and a geocentric theory is one of relative motion only, and that such a difference has no physical significance" (Astronomy and Cosmology—A Modern Course [San Francisco: W. H. Freeman and Co.], p. 416).

Philip Stott states about evangelical theologian G. C. Berkouwer, "At various times Christians have returned to the belief that the Bible is true in everything it touches upon. One such group included the famous Dutch theologian Abryam Kuiper, who accepted the Bible as inerrant. But the authority of science is persuasive, and G. C. Berhouwer, one of his disciples, even after years of Kuiper's influence, came to the conclusion that the Bible cannot be completely inerrant because it teaches geocentricity, which he believed science had shown to be untrue." (The Earth-Our Home. [N.P., 1996], p. 18).

Joseph: A Man of Integrity by Pastor Cas Reeves

"And the patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him, And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favour and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house"

Acts 7:9-10

Joseph the son of Jacob and Rachel is one of the greatest Bible characters given to us for an example

of godly living. Joseph who was singled out by God to receive futuristic visions were despised by his older brothers. His brothers staged his death and sold him to a caravan of Midianites (Gn.37:28) who took him to

Pastor Cas Reeves Egypt. In Egypt he was sold into the service of Potiphar's house who was captain of the guard to Pharaoh.

Joseph served Potiphar faithfully and with great integrity. Joseph's service to Potiphar was done well and Potiphar was very pleased with Joseph. However, he lost his job when Potiphar's wife set her lustful designs upon Joseph who recognized its wickedness and fled from her presents (Gn.39:9-12). After her accusation of Joseph he was cast into prison. Because the LORD was with him, he prospered even in prison.

Joseph revealed a dream to Pharaoh and was elevated to second in authority under Pharaoh. He guided Egypt through seven years of plenty and then seven years of famine. He was reunited with his family treating them kindly and generously in all ways toward them who had sold him, declaring "ye thought evil against me; but God meant it unto good" (Gn.50:20).

Joseph is an example of godly integrity, which embraces holiness and purity. Throughout his life he remained faithful to God and men, as well as, compassionate toward his family. Because the LORD was with Joseph, God continually blessed him, regardless of his circumstances and surroundings. Did you know that New Testament Believer has a similar position with the LORD: "lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world." (Mt. 28:20b). This should be an encouragement to all of us as we serve the Lord Jesus Christ. –CAR

The new home of Chester Baptist Church, Chester, MA




- 1) "I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well" (Ps. 139:14).
