Christianity and Morality

ARTICLE

Christianity is based theologically and historically upon the Judeo-Christian Scriptures known as the Old and New Testaments. The morality of the Bible finds its foundation on the command that the Lord God gave the first couple in the Garden of Eden before sin. They were to be fruitful and multiply (cf. Gen. 1:28) within the framework of the institution of marriage, as God stated, saying, *“Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh”* (Gen. 2:24). The Lord Jesus Christ cited this marital passage as the ongoing divine moral standard in His confrontation with the religious leaders of the day (cf. Mt. 19:5-6).

Both man and Satan have offered alternatives to the Lord God’s biblical pattern, which alternatives have brought countless heartbreaks and widespread immorality. One of the first aberrations to the Lord’s plan was Lamech’s polygamy (which engendered boasting and pride [cf. Gen. 4:23-24]). This seemed to open the door to the patriarch Jacob’s practice of having multiple wives, spiritually and emotionally hurting the family members (*vide* Gen. 29-30). Satan’s attempted aberration apparently was genetic tampering through the instrumentality of demonic cohabitation with women, therefore producing the Nephillim (cf. Gen. 6:1-4; Jude 1:6-7). Another aberration was Canaan’s immorality with his drunken grandfather Noah (cf. Gen. 9:20-25). Of course, Abram and Sarah’s general consent to include Hagar in family birthing was spiritually and theologically disastrous (cf. Gen. 16:1 ff.). An additional aberration was the effort of the inhabitants of Sodom to rape the two angels who appeared with Jehovah before Abraham (cf. Gen. 19:1-7 with 18:1). The Sodomites were stopped and destroyed by the Lord (cf. Gen. 19:8-28). The perverted mindset of Lot’s daughters led to another aberration of the Lord’s original plan when they

committed incest with their father (Gen. 19:30-38). Further human examples of aberrations to the institution of marriage were Shechem’s rape of Dinah (cf. Gen. 34:1-2) and Tamar’s harlotry with Judah (cf. Gen. 38:12-30). In striking contrast the Scripture recorded Joseph’s sterling character and behavior in the face of immoral temptation (cf. Gen. 39:7-18). The Judeo-Christian Scriptures have identified several human or demonic aberrations to God’s plan for morality, including the immoral activity of 1) bigamy, 2) demonic cohabitation with women, 3) sodomic incest, 4) concubine relationship, 5) sodomy, 6) incest, 7) rape, and 8) harlotry.

To exacerbate these moral aberrations (i.e., immorality) to God’s pattern for marriage has been the universal rejection of the theological teaching concerning the fulfillment of the seed promise through the institution of marriage. The LORD God promised that the seed of the woman would ultimately bruise the head of the serpent’s seed (cf. Gen. 3:15) within the framework of the formula of Gen. 2:24. This, of course, was fulfilled in history as Joseph and Mary, within the divine

pattern, acted out their respective roles as legal father and “surrogate” mother in the virgin conception of the holy body of the Lord Jesus Christ (cf. Isa. 7:14; Mt. 1:18-25 and Lk. 1:27-38). Thus all immorality strikes at the Seed promise within the institution of marriage and is therefore “anti-Seed” as well as anti-Christ!

It behooves Christians then to be faithful to their Scriptures, and renounce all aberrations to God’s pattern of marriage, and resist all temptations to be politically correct or socially acceptable. In the New Testament, the Apostle Paul declared, *“For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication”* (I Thes. 4:3).

"Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord" 2 Peter 1:20

There are great blessings to be found in the knowledge of God. Grace and peace are just two of those blessings. Salvation is another with the promise of finding the knowledge of God. *"If thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandment with thee; If thou criest after knowledge; If thou seekest her as silver and searchest for her as hid treasures; Then thou shalt understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God"* (Proverbs 2:1-5).

The knowledge of God is something Christians are expected to have. Paul admonishes the church at Corinth to *"awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame"* (1 Corinthians 15:34).


Christian if you want to understand the knowledge of God you must *"study to show yourself approved unto God a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of Truth"* (2 Timothy 2:15). Bringing your mind under Christ's discipline does this; *"Let*

this mind be in you which was also in Christ" (Philippians 2:5). *"Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ"* (2 Corinthians 10:5).

To the Romans, Paul wrote, *"O the depth of the riches both of wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out"* (Romans 11:33). But God has shared with us the secret of finding the deep riches of his knowledge. We find it written to the Hebrew Christians; *"For every one that useth the milk is unskillful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil"* (Hebrews 5:13-14).

When God shares truth with his children He expects them by true faith to believe it and to follow it in obedience through use. When that happens the Believer will find an alertness to the knowledge of God and many rich blessings. -CAR

Manchester Bible Study


