

We are thankful for those whom the Lord Jesus Christ has "set" in our assembly (I Cor. 12:18), and looking forward to the employment of their respective spiritual gift for the edification of the body (Rom. 12:1-8 and Eph. 4:12). We are thankful for the good attendance

for the morning service with a total of 46 in attendance. The PM baptismal service was held at Galilean Baptist Church in Stafford Springs, shepherded by Keith Main. As BBC was preparing to travel to GBC, the enemy caused a large branch to fall on the electrical wires over the church parking lot, with frightening crackling and fire, endangering our safety and potentially prohibiting our egress from the parking lot. The Lord intervened and no one was hurt—"but the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil" (II Thes. 3:3).

Bible Study in Manchester

BBC is praying about the possibility of starting a Bible Study in Manchester as a precursor to a church plant under the aegis of BBC. We want to be involved in the Great Commission, which is essentially the establishing of immersionist assemblies around the world, starting at home.

After experiencing the Satanic opposition on Sunday to our effort to practice the ordinance of baptism, I began to observe what the Lord is doing. He has affirmed the biblical authority of BBC as a candlestick in several ways.

Bible Study in Manchester (continued)

1. Initially, as several men began to pray and examine the Scripture about the starting of a new church in Central CT, the Lord confirmed through His Scriptures that church members start churches. Since our pattern of approach was in doctrinal harmony with the New Testament, the **Bible confirms our status as a NT Candlestick.**
 2. **The Lord God has blessed BBC** not only with new members, but with a new building, new furniture paid for, and sufficient funds with much excess to carry on the work of God.
 3. **Many men have shown their favor towards BBC**, such as with the attendance to the Spring Lecture Series in which at least fifteen area pastors attended and showed their support.
 4. **Satan has opposed BBC** at several critical times, attempting to thwart the work of the Lord.
- BBC's biblical authority is based upon 1) **conformity with the NT**, 2) **spiritual and material blessings from the Lord**, 3) **human approval from godly pastors**, and 4) **satanic opposition from the hater of truth**. In other words, **BBC/BBTS** has **biblical approval, heavenly approval, human approval, and satanic disapproval.**

How To Prepare For An Appointment You Cannot Miss

“And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:”

How can you be ready for your appointment with death and what follows? First, you can **recognize** the fact of your sinfulness and the fate of that sinfulness. *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; (Romans 3:23 For the wages of sin is death... (Romans 6:23a)*

Second, you can **resign** humbly to the fact that your sin’s fate is just and deserved. *And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. (Luke 18:13)*

Third, you can **repent** – which is to turn from yourself, your sin and anything and everything you have depended upon for salvation and turn to Christ alone. *I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. (Luke 13:3)*

Fourth, you can **request** by sincere prayer the sal-

vation provided by God in Christ. *For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16) For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. (Romans 10:13)*


Fifth, you can **receive** by faith the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior. *But as many as received him, to them gave he the power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: (John 1:12) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9)*

Note: If your faith is insufficient for acquiring this gift of salvation, God’s remedy for that insufficiency is the hearing of God’s Word. *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17). You will need the faithful preaching of God’s Word in a Bible preaching church. How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? (Romans 10:14)*
