DEVOTIONAL CORNER Seek God's Word by Pastor Cas Reeves

"Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read"

Isaiah 34:1

This is a command. We are ordered to seek the Word of the Lord and read. The impor-



tance of the Bible in our life can not be over stated. It is imperative that we get into God's Word and read it. The Apostle Paul said by inspiration of God, "Study to shew


Pastor Cas Reeves thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15).

Luke tells us in the book of Acts regarding the saints at Berea and those at Thessalonica. At Berea, we are told, "These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11).

When Joshua took over the leadership of Israel, the LORD gave him the similar mandate. "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success" (Joshua 1:8).

Again, the wisdom of Solomon reveals the physical blessing that we get as we remember God's Word. "My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee." Three things are promised: Time, Years, and Peace. We cannot afford to be indifferent to searching, reading and studying our Bible. We are commanded, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly [or abundantly]" (Colossians 3:16). Paul exhorts Timothy, by saying, "Till I come, give attendance to reading" (1 Timothy 4:13). The word, "attendance" means "to keep the mind." The idea is simple. Christian, we are to be "paying attention" to reading God's Word. Let us seek God's Word.


