Czech Republic is an atheistic nation, having been under the brunt of communism for so long, and its citizens are completely ignorant of anything religious or Christian. Certainly Paul's words are descriptive of Prague, Czech Republic, saying, "That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world"

toward the study of the parables. In the afternoon, Pastor Reeves taught a week long module class on Biblical Economics, emphasizing: personal stewardship of finances in the related areas of basic economics, debt, budgets and savings, including investments.

Sunday the 29th of September, Pastor Reeves preached in the morning service of the Cornerstone Baptist Church. A baptismal service followed the morning service. Pastor Raquintan and Pastor Reeves then traveled to Pompanga, which is two hours north of Quezon City, and preached to this new church plant



The Blessedness of the Word of God



When we think of blessing we usually think of things. Perhaps they are things that we have received, which we have asked for in our prayers. Yet the blessedness of God's words can truly bring us blessings. We are told that "...the word of God is quick, and powerful...," sharing

Pastor Cas Reeves with us that it is living and powerful, more so then even dynamite. The word of God is therefore a mighty tool to give blessings from God to His people.

One of the greatest places to find the blessedness of the word of God is Psalm 119. It reveals a number of areas that are a blessing to the child of God. First, we are told it brings us God's mercies and salvation: "Let thy mercies come also unto me, O LORD, even thy salvation, according to thy word" (Psalm 119:41). Secondly the word of God is able to give us direction and guidance throughout our lives: "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path" (Psalm 119:105). Thirdly, it is a source of strength to us in a time of emotional heaviness in our lives: "My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word" (Psalm 119:28). Fourthly, it brings the comfort that is real and gives us back our lives from anguish and despair: "This is my comfort in my affliction: for thy word hath quickened My soul melteth for heaviness: strengthen thou me according unto thy word" (Psalm 119:50). Fifthly, God's word, as light reveals, gives revelation to truth and to the things of life; as well, it gives us understanding or

the ability to comprehend things: "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple" (Psalm 119:130). Finally, it helps us when we place His words in our heart to live pleasingly with a clean or pure life before God and man: "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee" Psalm 119:11).

Certainly, these are only a few examples of the blessedness of the word of God for those who love and cherish their God, Creator and Savior. How much apart of your life is the word of God? -CAR


Several men from BBC attended the event. The food was tremendous. Activities included archery, pistol and firearm range, and skeet shooting on their softball field.

BBC Homeschoolers Visit the CT Old State House

On October 1st the homeschool group took a trip to Hartford to visit the Old State House. Built in 1796, it houses an original 1802 painting by Gilbert Stewart

of George Washington. The children learned much about the three branches of government, which where all housed The State House here until 1878. contains the Joseph Steward Museum of Curiosities. The curiosities included an eight and a half-foot alligator, a calf with two complete heads to one body, and collections of insects and butterflies. Several inventions, such as electrifying machines, are on exhibit. The museum is full of artificial and natural wonders. The highlight of the trip was the multisensory, multi-media exhibit that follows 300 years of Hartford's history. It included















