THE SECOND WAVE

In the account of the accession of David L to the throne in Hebron, the chronicler asserted this about "the children of Issachar, which were men that had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do;" (I Chr. 12:32). In having "understanding of the times," they recognized the all-embracing will of God in history relative to human government and spiritual responsibility. In the providential working of Jehovah, He orchestrated the events that led to David's ultimate rule over Israel culminating in his everlasting dynasty (II Sam. 7:12-16). Certainly as Solomon declared, "The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will" (Prov. 21:1). The LORD controls the nations and has allowed at this time professed socialist dictators to regain control of the United States of America. As globalism and dictatorship begin to foment again, this time without restraint, the world seemingly is prepared for the ruthless but brilliant dictator, the ultimate betrayer, who will be divinely allowed to usher in the Tribulation (Dan.7:25; 9:27; II Thes. 2:3-12; Rev. 13:3-18).

The only hope that the believer has ever I had is *"the blessed hope"* of the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ! The Christian's hope is not in a political party or in a world politician or even in the United States government! Therefore, the Lord's pastors and churches need to develop a biblical "understanding of the times" and recognize Satan's master plan. He has orchestrated the lockdown of nations under the guise of the physical concern and welfare of mankind. For the most part, Satan has been successful because some of the Lord's people have received spiritual deception and lacked spiritual discernment. Many pastors and churches obeyed Caesar and disobeyed the Lord Jesus Christ (Mk. 12:17) by not assembling. - 3. I have walked in thy truth (3)
- 4. I have not sat with vain persons (4)
- 5. I will neither go in with dissemblers (4)
- 6. I have hated the congregation of evil doers (5)
- 7. I will not sit with the wicked (5)
- 8. I will wash mine hands in innocency (6)

- 9. I will compass thine altar, O LORD (7)
- 10. I may publish with the voice of thanksgiving (7)
- 11. I will tell of all thy wondrous works (7)
- 12. I have loved the habitation of thy house (8)
- 13. I have loved the place where thine honour dwelleth (8)
- 14. I will walk in mine integrity (11)
- 15. I will bless the LORD (12)

These behaviors are challenging to keep, but they are possible. Can the behavior of your life stand the judgment and examination of the LORD? Praise God for the promise of Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."




