BBTS MODULE ON THE JOHANNINE EPISTLES


n Monday, March 1, 2021, BBC hosted the BBTS Spring module on the Johannine Epistles, dealing with the exegesis and exposition of I, II, and III John. The class studied the Textus Receptus Greek and KJV English as several seminarians presented rough translations and compared them



with the marvelous KJV. Prof. Clint Schreiber, BBTS ThD candidate, contributed observations as well in the intense study of these books. Prof. Schreiber is the Bible professor at Fairhaven Baptist College in Chestertown, IN.

r. Scott A. Blair, III, the Doctor of Ministry graduate from BBTS in 2020 wrote his 200 page dissertation on the Book of Colossians. He sensed the burden to put his academic work in a book not only for academicians, but also for pastors and church members. His book is entitled "And Ye are Complete in Him..." A Thorough Study of the Book of Colossians, published by Willow Grove Baptist Theological Press. In the 292 pages, the book gives a detailed outline of Colossians and a running commentary on each verse, a section on the theology of Colossians, and four Appendices including a color map of Paul's 3rd Missionary Journey.

Dr. Blair has been the pastor of Willow Grove Baptist Church in Waynesburg, PA since 2007. Pastor Blair has been married to his wife Kelly for 26 years and together

HOW TO GET RIGHT WITH GOD

1. Realize that God Loves You

John 3:16: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." Always remember that God loves the sinner but hates the sin. This is the reason He sent His for us and for our good.

2. Be Honest with God and Judge Yourself

1 Corinthians 11: 31-32: "For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be

condemned with the world." If you are not willing to honestly judge yourself before God, He cannot help you.

3. Seek God's Mercy by Acknowledging and Forsaking Your Sins

Proverbs 28:13: "He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh them shall have mercy." If you treat your sins lightly, covering over them, God promises you that you shall not prosper. But if you repent, have a change of mind, then you can have His mercy or blessings, which is much better than His judgment or cursing.

4. Claim God's Promise of Forgiveness and Cleansing

1 John 1:9: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." You must talk to God about your sin—asking Him for forgiveness and when you are genuine in your confession, He will forgive you and cleanse you from your iniquities.

5. Remember It is His Strength that Can Keep you Right with God

Philippians 4:13: "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." It should be obvious that our strength is weak, but His is strong, therefore we need to rely in His enabling strength rather than our weakness.

6. Victory Over Sin Comes from Being in the Word of God

Psalm 119:9-11: "Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word. With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments. Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." The key to overcoming our sins is the Word of God.

7. Trust What God says

1 Corinthians 10:13: "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it." Finally, God promises us that He will not allow us to be tempted more than we can handle and will also always give us a way to escape in victory.
