BBTS MODULE IN PA

uring the week of June 7-11, 2021, the Lord blessed the Bible Baptist Theological Seminary module on Ezra-Nehemiah with 26 students enrolled. Pastor David Smith hosted the module at his Community Baptist Church in Coopersburg, PA. This was the sixteenth year that he and his

church hosted the seminary module. We are thankful for his friendship and it was a joy to see his pastoral staff enrolled with a number of church members. Also several graduates of Bible Baptist Theological Seminary attended the module to continue their training in Scripture, including Dr. David Smith, Dr. Noel Meadowcroft, Pastor Jon Stockton, and Professor Clint Schreiber. Moreover, candidates for Bible Baptist Theological Seminary degrees attended as well, including Pastor Adam Shedal, Pastor David Smith, Jr., Pastor Stephen Hinebaugh, and Mr. K. C. Stoddard.

These two Old Testament books focused on the Lord's desire to have His meeting place with the saints, i.e., the Second Temple (Zerubbabel-Herod Temple), built in Jerusalem and protected with a wall around the city. The emphasis is that the Lord has designated a visible meeting place for His people in every dispensation including the local church dispensation.

JACK A. MOORMAN TRIBUTE

September 3, 1941 - May 31, 2021

My personal and ministerial friend Jack A. Moorman is alive and well since he has entered into the presence of his Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ. He was a mighty warrior for the defense of the Scriptures who has now ceased from the battle. Nevertheless, his legacy of many books defending the King James Version and the underlying texts continue to edify, encourage, and enhance believers concerning the word of God. His love for the precious Lord Jesus Christ was evinced by his love for the Lord's words.



Brother Moorman and I had many similarities in our service for the Lord. He and I both attended simultaneously Eagledale Baptist Church in Indianapolis and received the preaching and teaching ministry of Pastor Warren Dafoe, Sr. We grew under Pastor Dafoe's challenge for Christian service. His wife Dottie influenced my wife Jan when they were younger. As a young teenager Dottie babysat my wife-to-be Jan while she was a pre-adolescent. Quite often they walked to Eagledale Baptist Church for services. In our teen years both Jack and I boxed in the Indianapolis Golden Gloves Boxing Tourney, albeit in different years.

Later, we both became convinced of the superiority of the King James Version and its underlying Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek texts. While we were independent in our studies of the preeminent position of the King James Version among English translations, we collaborated with our research and defense. We both wrote books and articles in defense of the King James Version and its manuscript evidence and biblical support.

Interesting as well, when Jack heard that I believed in and wrote about Geocentricity, he shared that he had been studying this subject for many years and became convinced of the truth of the stationary earth. He put his research in book form and printed his excellent work entitled *The Biblical and Observational Case for Geocentricity*. A Place Rather than a Path for the Earth (2013).

Furthermore he was a faithful husband, father, and pastor. For many years he shepherded the Bethel Baptist Church in London, England. Certainly it could be said of him that he fought the good fight, he finished his course, and he kept the faith (cf. II Tim. 4:7). -Dr. Thomas M. Strouse

EIGHT REASONS FROM PSALMS TO GIVE THANKS

We have much to be thankful for as we reflect upon our families, our many mundane blessings, and many times our "taken for granted" physical health. But most of all we should be thankful to our Creator, God, Savior and

Lord. It is therefore a timely thing to share eight reasons from the Book of Psalms for giving thanks to our Lord and God.

1. Because the LORD gives deliverance from evil men:

Ps.18:48-49: He delivereth me from mine enemies: yea, thou liftest me up above those that rise up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man. Therefore will I give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and sing praises unto thy name.

2. Because the LORD is holy:

Ps. 30:4: Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.

Ps. 97:12: Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.

3. Because the LORD is our Helper:

Ps. 30:10-12: Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper. Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness; To the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.

4. Because of God's wondrous works:

Ps. 75:1: Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, unto thee do we give thanks: for that thy name is near thy wondrous works declare.

5. Because it is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD:

Ps. 92:1: It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

Ps. 105:1: O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people.

6. Because of God's grace and mercy:

Ps. 106:1: Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 107:1: O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 118:1: O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: because his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 118:29: O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 136:1: O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 136:2: O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 136:3: O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endureth for ever.

Ps. 136:26: O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever.

7. Because of God's righteous judgments:

Ps. 119:62: At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments.


8. Because of the name of the LORD:

Ps. 140:13: Surely the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name: the upright shall dwell in thy presence.
