
AND YE ARE COMPLETE IN HIM...

r. Scott A. Blair, III, the Doctor of Ministry graduate from BBTS in 2020 wrote his 200 page dissertation on the Book of Colossians. He sensed the burden to put his academic work in a book not only for academicians, but also for pastors and church members. His book is entitled "And Ye are Complete in Him…" A Thorough Study of the Book of Colossians, published by Willow Grove Baptist Theological Press. In the 292 pages, the book gives a detailed outline of Colossians and a running commentary on each verse, a section on the theology of Colossians, and four Appendices including a color map of Paul's 3rd Missionary Journey.

Dr. Blair has been the pastor of Willow Grove Baptist Church in Waynesburg, PA since 2007. Pastor Blair has been married to his wife Kelly for 26 years and together they have five children: Brittany, Haley, Grace, Scott IV, and Joseph. He graduated

from West Virginia University (BS) in 1992. In 2003, Dr. Blair and his family relocated to Connecticut where he completed his MBS from Emmanuel Baptist Theological Seminary in Newington, CT. Since returning to Pennsylvania, Dr. Blair has subsequently completed his M.Div (2018) and his DMin (2020) from Bible Baptist Theological Seminary in Cromwell, CT. LIVING BY FAITH

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Heb. 11:6

It should be the desire of every born again child of God to want to please the One who has done so much for them. Truly of all


the people in the world the saved person is able to recognize and appreciate the great sacrifice of God in sending His only begotten Son on our behalf and for our blessing (John 3:16). In return God asks of His children to obey Him, "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15).

We are told in our text that we must have "faith" in order to please God. If we think about it, our Christian life begins with faith in Christ Jesus (John 6:47), and it continues through faith in God's words (Psalm 119:105). So certainly the key to faith is the Word of God. And so we are told, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17).

Living by faith relies upon believing what God teaches us from His Scripture. It does not depend upon our rational thinking. For example, we cannot prove there is a God to the unbeliever who is rationally trying to find or reject Him. It is a faith matter that one chooses to believe there is a God. God simply says, "I AM That I AM" (Exodus 3:14). For the believer, his trust or faith or confidence is in God and what He says, and what He says is found recorded in the Scriptures.

We note that living in faith toward God many times defies our rationalism, relying solely upon what the Lord says. Take the Apostle Peter for an example. On the authority of one word from the Lord Jesus, "come" Peter defies the logic of all mankind and did the impossible, "And he (Jesus) said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus" (Matthew 14:29). Abraham is another example of living by faith. At God's direction Abraham left all that was secure to him, including family to look for a new place, which he knew not, "By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God." (Hebrews 11:8-10).

And so it is, the Scripture is replete with example after example that the truly faithful begin their life by faith and live their life by faith. Biblical faith is not logical as men count logic; rather it simply trusts God and what He says. The believer recognizes this as Biblical logic. He finds that it is both good for the soul and for life; as well, it pleases God. Are you living by faith? -CAR
